Saturday July 16th

Comes in with fresh breezes from the S.W. and quite clear weather - Ship by the wind on different tacks working to the W. with all prudent sail set - in the morn. the Wm & Henry in sight but went out of sight to the S.W. - all day water very blue and some tallow - porpoises in sight - saw several sail steering to the E. - at 3 P.M. comes in foggy - shortened sail and at 7¹/₂ hove to under easy sail

Sunday July 17th

Comes in with fresh breezes from the S.W. and thick foggy weather the most of the time - only lightening up now and then for awhile - at 7 P.M. saw a whale spouting some little distance astern but coming in foggy could not make out for certain what it was but called it sperm whale - water blue all day with some jellies and Portegue man of tot. war. - some birds and Calbacore and schools of small fish

Cruising For Sperm Whales

Monday July 18th

Comes in with moderate breezes from the S.W. and somewhat foggy - Ship on various tacks working to the W. cruising - One sail in sight at 9 P.M. spoke the Wm & Henry Green of Fair Haven 2¹/₂ mos. 140 bbls of Sperm Oil - Capt. Green came on board for a gam. and remained until 6 P.M. both ships in sight all day - see porpoises birds and some Seagulls also two or three sail steering to the E.

Tuesday July 19th

Comes in with light moderate breezes from the S and hazy weather - Ship by the wind to the W. with all prudent sail out - at 8 A.M. lost sight of it to the water blue all day with but little indications of whales - at 12 heaved ship to the W. again nothing but two sail in sight through the day

Wednesday July 20th

Comes in with moderate breezes from the S. and thick weather with fog. Ship in the A.M. steering A.W. with all prudent sail out. In the P.M. steering N. - nothing in sight today but one school of porpoises - water blue and green alternately
