Monday 22nd Aug

Comes in with strong breezes from the S.W. and S.E. with squally weather. Spoke and forwarded letters to a Spanish Bark 24 days from Cuba Bound for Barcelona Spain all day ship cruising to the N.W. nothing in sight but vessels and a few porpoises. Lat at merid 41.58 Long by Chron. 49.36 Long by Bk 49.32

Tuesday Aug. 23rd

Comes in with light baffling winds from E and S.E. with squalls of rain. Saw several sail and at 5 P.M. spoke Bk Ocean Stead Russell of New York. 34 mos. with 130 Bbls of Sperm Oil - had seen nothing late by. Lat at merid 41.58 Long by Chron. 49.19 Long by C.S. 46.30

Wednesday Aug. 24th

Comes in with moderate breezes from S.W. and clear weather mostly but some squalls of rain. Ship cruising to the S. with all prudent sail and in Co. with Bk. O.S. at night under easy sail standing to the S. weather squally. at 5 land to and led the O.S. have 20 Bushels of potatoes. Lat at merid 41.04 Long by Chron. 49.09

Thursday Aug. 25th

all day light air and calm with good weather. at 6 saw Blackfish lowered and chased with 4 Boats without success in P.M. one sail in sight - in the night she, it proved to be ship Campbell with logwood from Haiti for Bristol E. Lat 40.24

Friday Aug. 26th

Comes in with light baffling winds from N.W. and fine weather. Ship by the wind to the S with all sail and. Saw crew paces and Dullow Drep and some small porpoise man of war, at 5 P.M. saw Blackfish several schools and also cow fish and porpoises lowered all five Boats and chased without success - all going to the N.W. saw also several schools of small fish. Lat at merid 40.56 Long by Chron. 46.09

Saturday Aug. 27th

Comes in with moderate breezes from the N.W. and fine pleasant weather. Ship by the wind to the N.W. with all sail and at 5 saw Blackfish lowered and chased with all five Boats without success. Blackfish going E.S.E. per compass - saw several sail through the day. Lat at merid 40.46 Long by Chron. 48.49

Sunday Aug. 28th

Comes in with strong breezes from the S and cloudy weather. Ship steering S.W. all day nothing in sight but humpbacks in the morning water rather green temp. 76 in the P.M. water blue with some few flying fish and one flock of birds of about 1000 one or two dolphins - nothing more but two or three sail all bound to the E. Lat at merid 40.24 Long by Chron. 47.19
