Monday Jan. 9th

Comes in with strong breezes from the N.E. and hazy weather - Ship steering S.W. under double reefed topsails - nothing in sight all day - at night shortened sails

Comes in with moderate breezes from the N.E. - regular trades - and smoky weather - Ship steering S.W. per compass with all prudent sail set - watch employed in repairing old maintop sail - in the P.M. bent it and unbent the new one and put it below.
