

Ship Com. Morris of New Bedford

Friday June 9th

Comes in with moderate breezes from S.E.W. and fine pleasant weather. Ship by the wind to the S.E. with all sail out. Nothing in sight all day. at 5 1/2 P.M. tacked ship holding W.N.W. at 12 M. put the cook in single irons he abusing quarrelling and fighting with the steward. The cook has been very abusive, and disobedient to orders Joe. Shepherd went in the galley to do the cooking for awhile. Lat at merid 22.40 Long at 7 a.m. 65.02 at 5 P.M. 64 1/2

Saturday June 10th

Comes in with moderate breezes from the S.W. and hazy weather. Ship by the wind working to the Windward. at 11 1/4 raised the island of Bermuda bearing W. Dist. 10 miles Ship working up all the P.M. at 6 P.M. off St. Blais Head. Pilot Boat came on board but left again in a few minutes weather rather showery.

Sunday June 11th

Comes in with light breezes from the N and N.E. and fine weather. Ship working in for the landing at Bermuda at Pelagary Bay at 12 went on shore and obtained letters lying off and on all night

Monday June 12th

all day fine weather. Ship lying off and on at Bermuda obtaining recruits. Took on board 9 bbls of Potatoes and 400 lbs of onion through the night strong breezes with showers of rain. spoke Bk Wave Briggs of N.Y. 1 mtd out 12 bbls Blackfish oil came in for recruits

Cabin Clerks - Cook and other attendants - stowmen - all colored are supposed to have jumped overboard and started for the shore as both were found missing at 1 P.M.

Cruising In The Atlantic Ocean

Tuesday June 13th

Comes in with moderate breezes from S.W. and hazy weather. Ship lying off and on at Bermuda obtaining recruits in lee with Bk Wave. at 6 left the island steering to the N and E until 12 to keep clear the reef that makes out to the N.

Wednesday June 14th

Comes in with strong breezes from the S.W. and rainy weather. Ship by the wind to the N.W. for the Gulf Stream. saw one sail steering to the S.E. - No Obs

Thursday June 15th

Comes in with moderate breezes and fine weather from the W. Ship by the wind with all sail out to the N.W. - no signs of whales - no birds or porpoises or anything else Lat at merid 34.40 Long by Chron. 66.25

Friday June 16th

Comes in with strong breezes from S.W. and rainy weather with much thunder and lightning. Ship by the wind on different tacks to the N.W. with all prudent sail out. nothing in sight all day. water blue and clear Lat at merid 35.39 Long by Chron. 68.35

Saturday June 17th

Comes in with light winds from the E and S.E. and fine weather. Ship steering to the N.W. with all sail out. No signs of whales - saw several sail through the day.

Lat at merid 35.27 Long by Chron. 69.35
