

Ship Comm. Morris of New Bedford

Sunday June 18th

Comes in with fresh breezes from S. E. and coming to the S. Ship steering to the N. W. with all sail out. - saw one school of porpoises but nothing like whales a few gulls - water blue and clear

In the P. M. steering N. E. until 4 P. M. then luffed up to E. - at night shortened sail steering E. N. E.

Monday

Tuesday June 19th

Comes in with strong gales from S. W. and hazy weather - ship by the wind to the W. N. W. all the first part. Last part steering N. W. with all prudent sail out. - saw three or four sail today. Lat 38.25

Wednesday June 20th

Comes in with strong gales from the W. and cloudy weather. Ship steering E per compass all day with all prudent sail out. - saw two sail both steering to the E. - nothing more in sight all day. Lat by bal. 39.40

Thursday June 21st

Comes in with fresh breezes from the W. N. W. and all through the first part strong - last part squally - saw several sail steering to the E. saw some birds in the P. M. one school of albacore

Cruising in The North Atlantic

Thursday June 22nd

Comes in with fresh breezes from the W. N. W. and somewhat squally weather. Ship steering E by N with all sail out. - saw several sail all steering to the E. - saw two schools of porpoises and several birds but no other indications of whales. Lat 39.23

Long 59.45

Friday June 23rd

Begins with fresh breezes from the N and N. E. with fine weather. Ship steering E by N. with all sail out. - several sail in sight - at 1 P. M. spoke the Bk. C. S. nothing since last saw her - jammed with her until 6 - had seen whales only once since we saw her last. - reports nothing - all through the day saw plenty of albacore some Gulf tides and some birds etc. - nearly calm all day. Lat 39.32

Saturday June 24th

Begins with moderate breezes from the W. and fine weather. Ship steering E by S. per compass with all sail out. - saw several sail all steering to the E and N. E. - C. S. still in sight. In the P. M. saw several schools of Blackfish all going S. W. quick with the Blackfish were porpoises and Calfish. Lat at mid 39.53
