

Ship Com^d Morris of New BedfordTuesday Aug. 8th

Came in with light baffling winds from the S.W. and quite clear weather - Ship cruising to the S. with all prudent sail out - nothing in sight but two sails steering to the E. and two schools of Grampuses - Water blue and clear - nothing in it but a very few jellies -

Lat 43.05
Long 32.31

Wednesday, Aug. 9th

Came in with moderate breezes from the N.E.W. and fine weather - Ship by the wind cruising to the S and W. - through the day saw several schools of Grampuses and several do of porpoises but nothing like whales - saw several sails steering to the E.

Lat 41.32
Long 31.44

Thursday, Aug. 10th

Came in with light air from the N and N.W. and fine weather all day - at daylight saw the island of ~~Punta~~ bearing S by E Dist 40 miles - Ship steering S per Compass all day at 8 a.m. saw the island of Flores bearing S by W Dist 45 miles - at sunset leave bearing E S E Dist 15 miles - saw several sails through the day

Friday, Aug. 11th

Came in with fine pleasant weather light breezes from S.W. Ship lying off and on at Punta Delgada at 8 a.m. went on shore for the purpose of obtaining recruits - purchased 550 Eggs, a quantity of Fowl - 1 Beef creature a lot of pigs and 100 lbs of Irish Potatoes Took on board Eggs. 1 1/2 doz Fowl 2 pigs &c

At Punta Delgada - Flores - W.I.

Saturday Aug. 12th

All this day fine pleasant weather, light breezes from P.W. - Ship off and on at Punta Delgada Flores obtaining recruits - In the a.m. sent in a raft of 20 casks for fresh water but there being so much scum on was unable to fill the casks. Took them in tow and went around to the W side of the island and filled them and left them on the beach for the night being too late to get them on board Took on board as recruits 550 Eggs, 8 doz. chickens 100 lb of fresh Beef, 12 pigs, 1 doz pumpkins a lot of Apples pears, melons corn Wheat, and 100 lbs of Potatoes.

Sunday Aug. 13th

All day fine weather with light breezes from S.E. to E - Ship lying off and on at Punta Delgada on Fresh Water but near by - Took on board and stowed in the lower hold about 180 Bbls of Fresh Water being the raft left on shore last night

Monday Aug. 14th

First part cloudy foggy and rainy weather with moderate breezes from N.W. Ship lying off and on at F. Water Bay Flores at 11 sent in another raft of 20 casks for water with 3 boats and at 2 came on board with it being about 180 Bbls - stowed it below and stowed out to the N.W. by the wind - at sunset shortened sail - Saw through the day several birds and one school of porpoises - Plenty of Vallen Drops in the water with some jellies - good indications for whales
