All day moderate breezes from the N.W. and fine pleasant weather in the morn. saw two square head Grampuses also saw one Dead Grampuse. Ship steering to the E all day - water rather green. In the P.M. saw some Dead stools water of a dark green but a very few birds

Friday Jan. 31st 1873
All day strong breezes from the N. and clear sky but hazy horizon being rather poor seeing. Ship by the wind to the N.E.W. with two reefs in the topsails - saw jumpers and one school of porpoises - water all the A.M. rather green and thick but nothing in it

Saturday Feb. 1st 1873
All this day moderate breezes from the N and calms. Ship by the wind to the N.W. with all sail out but foretopgall sail out. Nothing in sight all day - no indications of whales. In the P.M. will in on the edge of the Banks but nothing seen. Water blue and clear

Sunday Feb. 2d 1873
Comes in with moderate breezes from the N and cloudy weather. Ship cruising all day on different tracks with all prudent sail out. The weather overcast and squally & rain at 8 P.M. spoke U.S. Steam Ship Lancaster 3 days from Montevideo cruising. obtained papers from her and sold her a Whale Boat for \$40 Gold

Monday Feb. 3d 1873
All day strong breezes from the S & S.W. and quite fine weather - good seeing but nothing to be seen. Ship steering to the N.E. & N.E. in the A.M. in the P.M. to the E wind S.E. - water rather blue & clear but nothing in and no signs of whales

Tuesday Feb. 4th 1873
All day light baffling winds from the N. and cloudy weather. Ship by the wind cruising on different tracks but nothing in sight all day. Water rather blue but no indications of whales

Wednesday Feb. 5th 1873
All day light baffling winds from the N & N.E. & calms. Nothing in sight all day - no indications of whales

Thursday Feb. 6th 1873
All day light baffling winds from N.E. & N. Ship working to the South with all sail out. Nothing in sight all day. Water green all day

Friday Feb. 7th 1873
All day light baffling winds from the S.W. and fine weather. Ship on different tracks working to the S.W. with all sail out. One sail in sight. Ship in clear blue water all day but no birds or other indications of whales working for Cape Barrientes
