All day Fresh breezes from S.W. and W. with a very heavy swell running from the same quarter. Ship steering by the wind to the S. & E. & E. cruising. Nothing in sight but a few birds watered Green all day but nothing in it

All day strong gales from the N.W. and cloudy weather with some rain. Nothing in sight all day. Ship in Green water unable to find blue

All day Blowing a gale from N.W. N & S.W. Ship working to the N with all prudent sail out. From 10 A.M. until 4 P.M. trying to under easy sail. Blowing very heavy. Nothing in sight all day but a very few birds

Tuesday Feb. 18th 1873

All day Moderate breezes from the S.W. & S. and fine weather. Ship steering N by W all day with all prudent sail out cruising. Ship in Green water all day. Saw two sail steering to the S.W. - saw two schools of porpoises

Wednesday Feb. 19th 1873

All day strong gales from the S & E with light showers of rain. Nothing in sight all day. Ship working to the N. with all prudent sail out cruising. poor seeing all day.

Thursday Feb. 20th 1873

All day strong gales from the E and squally weather. Ship by the wind to the N.E. under double reefed topsails cruising. Nothing in sight all day poor seeing. Being squally with some rain

Friday Feb. 21st 1873

All day strong gales and squally weather from the E. Ship by the wind cruising to the N.E. under double reefed topsails. poor seeing nothing but a few birds one or two schools of porpoises in sight

Saturday Feb. 22^d 1873

All day strong gales from the S.E. but mostly cloudy weather with some light squalls of rain. Ship by the wind to the N & E with all prudent sail out. Saw a few birds and one school of porpoises. at 1 P.M. spoke a French Bark 63 days from Bordeaux for Montevideo with wine no report. Saw also several sail steering to the S.W.

Sunday Feb. 23^d 1873

All day Fresh breezes from the E with clear weather. Ship by the wind to the N.E. with all sail but foretopgall sail out. Saw several merchant vessels steering to the S.W. - clear weather and good seeing but nothing but a few birds one school of porpoises and a few albatross to be seen
