 All day strong N.E. trades and good weather & a smooth sea. Ship steering NW per compass with all sail out at 12 P.M. kept ship up to NW by it for the Bermudas. Nothing in sight all day.

Friday April 25th 1873
 All day strong trades from the N.E. and fine weather and a smooth sea. Ship steering NW by it with all sail out. Nothing in sight. No signs of whales. Water rather green with plenty of small flying fish.

Saturday April 26th 1873
 All day fresh trades from the N.E. and fine pleasant weather. Ship steering N.N.W. with all sail out. Nothing in sight all day.
 Lat 11.53 N
 Long 53.20 W

Sunday April 27th 1873
 All day strong trades from the N.E. and fine pleasant weather. Ship steering N.N.W. with all sail out. Nothing in sight all day.

Monday April 28th 1873
 All day strong N.E. trades and fine weather. Ship steering N.N.W. with all sail out. One sail in sight steering to the W.

Tuesday April 29th 1873
 All this day strong N.E. trades inclining to the E. - and fine pleasant weather. Nothing in sight all day.

Wednesday April 30th 1873
 All day strong and light trades alternately from E to E.S.E. & S.E. inclining to the South. Ship steering N.N.W. with all sail out. Nothing in sight all day but one sail steering to the W.N.W. with all sail out.

Thursday May 1st 1873
 All day light airs & calms - air from the S & fine pleasant weather. Ship steering N.N.W. with all sail out. Nothing in sight all day but one fin back.

 Long 59 54

Friday May 2nd 1873
 All day light baffling airs & calms - Ship steering N.N.W. with all sail out. Nothing in sight all day but one sail steering to the N.W.
 Lat 25.16 N
 Long 60 48 W

Saturday May 3rd 1873
 Comes in with strong breeze from the N.E. and squally weather. Ship steering N.N.W. with all sail out. Two sail in sight both steering to the N.E. No indications of whales. But porpoises caught two.
 Lat 26.13
 Long 62.27

Sunday May 4th 1873
 All day fresh breeze from the S.E.W. and fine pleasant weather. Ship steering to the N.N.W. with all sail out. No indications of whales. Two sail in sight steering to the W.N.W.
 Lat. 28 20
