

Remarks on board ship Addison

Tues 13th these twenty four hours commenced with a moderate breeze and a steady rain, all sail set steering on the wind. at 9 AM. gave some new jib sheet, wind about S. E. middle part heavy squall at 11 AM. gave down the topsails and reefed the fore & Mizzen, standing on the wind all night, was wearing ship every few hours. Ship heading N. on the Starboard tack, back & S. E. by S on the other. at 5 PM. turned the ship out of the fore topsail. latter part squally with heavy rain. no observation

Wed 14th these twenty four hours commenced with a squally weather and rain at 2 PM. set the M & Fore & Main Sails. middle part very light breeze. at 2 PM. moderate breeze with rain steering S. E. at 6 AM. calmed to light breeze during the latter part gave some new Mizzen Toppail sheets. no observation to day

Th 15th these twenty four hours commenced with a light breeze. Main Top Sails set. Steered S. W. at 7 PM. wore ship and headed to the North. at 10 PM. calmed at 1 PM. light breeze from the S. E. ship heading S. E. wore ship at 2 PM. at 4 PM. raised white water on the sea bow wore ship again and stood to the Eastward. at daylight wore again and made all sail. at 9 AM. raised a breach from aloft (probably a jumper) employed the latter part working in the rigging. latter part light breeze and very pleasant.

Fri 16th the day commenced with a light breeze steering on the wind Ship heading S. E. wind about S. E. employed

Sat 16th in the rigging. at 7 PM. gave the ship of. W. S. at 4 PM. kept the steering by the wind. Ship heading S. W. S. middle and latter part light breeze Lat - 18° 1' N

Long 159° 41' W

Sat 17th these twenty four hours commenced with a light breeze all sail set steering on the wind employed in the rigging. at 4 PM. slide up the H. Sail and put in some reefing and then set again. middle and latter part much like the fore part. employed the latter part in rigging up an old topsail Lat - 00° 49' N

Long 160° 00'

Sun 18th these twenty four hours commenced with a light air from the Eastward employed the fore part in rigging an old topsail. at 4 PM. set fore. middle & latter part much like the fore part. Lat - 01° 11' N

Long 160° 09'

Mon 19th these twenty four hours commenced with a very light fair steering S. E. wind about S. E. middle & latter part moderate breeze Lat - 04° 09' S

Long 160° 55'

Tues 20th these twenty four hours commenced with a moderate breeze and smooth sea all sail set steering on the wind Ship heading to the Southward and E. Eastward employed in mending sails with light air. at 6 PM. raised Whales at about 7 PM. all four boats and hauled until 3 PM. light breeze was for twenty four hours

Wed 21st these twenty four hours commenced with a very light breeze employed in chasing Whales. some there up and
