

Remarks on Board Ship Addison Capt Lawless

Sat 26th these twenty four hours commenced with a moderate gale of wind ship under reefed top-sails heading to the Southward & Eastward wind from the Southward and Westward. at 4 PM. saw the men down from aloft. middle part fresh gale. wind about S. ship heading N. S. on one tack and E. S. on the other. at 5 AM. saw a sail steering about N. E. W. latter part more moderate. at 6 AM. set the jib and Mr. M. stagsail. ship heading about S. W. on the larboard tack. so ends

Lat 36 00 S

Long 170

Sun 29th these twenty four hours commenced with a strong breeze ship under reefed top-sails jib & I sails. at 1 PM. turned the reef out of the top-sail & set the courses. ship heading to the Southward & Westward. the Air being to grow quite chilly. we all got along together for a while every thing appears to go along smoothly. middle part moderate breeze. with a heavy swell running at 4 PM. turned the reef out of I. Risen top-sail at 4. made all sail. so ends this day with a moderate breeze and quite a smooth sea and clear Sun shine. service at 5 AM & 8 PM

Long 166 40

Mon 30th these twenty four hours commenced with a moderate breeze. all sail set. ship sharp on the wind heading to the Southward & Westward. middle part breeze very light ship heading S. W. wind about S. E. latter part wind S. E. standing on the eastern tack. so ends this day. Lat 37 11 N S

Long 168 01

Tues 31st these twenty four hours commenced with a light breeze. all sail set. wind about S. E. at 2 PM. one ship and headed on the Western tack. weather very beautiful. and remarkable smooth sea on middle part moderate breeze. heading to the Southward & Westward. most of these twenty four hours. so ends. Lat 38 09 S

On New Zealand January 28th 1860

Mon Feb 1st February 1st these twenty four hours commenced with a fresh breeze all sail set wind about S. E. ship heading to the Southward & Westward at 2 PM. turned the Barge (Bow Boat) up and left a S. E. middle and latter part moderate breeze and beautiful weather. the employed proceeded in making Linnet. so ends. Lat 38 11 S S

Long 165 44 W

Th 2nd these twenty four hours commenced with a moderate breeze all sail set steering on the wind ship heading to the Southward and Westward. wind from the Southward & Eastward at 10 PM. raised a fresh breeze middle and latter part very light air. employed the latter part in getting the Steadings in blocks ready so ends. Lat 38 11 S S

Th 3rd.

these twenty four hours commenced with a calm. employed in making specigard. on sail in sight. middle part much the same. latter part moderate breeze steering S. E. wind about N. E. & employed the latter part in making a better bottom stay for the upper dudge. one sail in sight so ends. Lat 38 04 S

Long 164 43

Sat 4th these twenty four hours commenced with a moderate breeze all sail set steering S. E. employed in making specigard. a beautiful day but no whales in sight. saw three schools of porpoise all heading to the Eastward going quick. I am troubled to day with the tooth ache my great Medicine (Cassia) does not ease them as it once did. middle and latter part fresh breeze. all sail set steering S. E. at 5 AM. a

Brig passed across our bow steering about E. N. E. & E. S. E. probably from Australia bound to some port in New Zealand. so ends employed the latter part in making out fresh water. so ends
