Wednesday November 2th

First part pleasant with light breezes from W to S W steering
S S E by S by compass under all sail employed
fitting a new Boat at 11 Am finished & put her on the
Starboard crains we took the stoves on in latter part the
same employed breaking out for Powderline & various other
duties and sail in sight steering S S E so ends this day
Lat by obs 32.23 N
Long by Chron 36.42 W

Thursday Nov 3th

First part pleasant with light baffling wind steering from
S E to S by E by compass 3 sails in sight all hands
employed setting up rigging we also sent out Fly jibboom
& bent the Fly jib latter part light & breezes from N
so ends this day
Lat by obs 31.20 N
Long by Chron 35.06 W

Friday Nov 4th

First part pleasant with light breezes from the W steering
S by compass watch employed in various duties latter
part the same so ends this day

Saturday Nov 5th

First part pleasant with light breezes from W steering
S by compass watch employed breaking out between
decks to stow away some spars and sail in sight
steering South latter part the same at 5 Pm wind
S S W heading of S E so ends this day
Lat by obs 28.46 N
Long by Chron 34.29 W

Sunday Nov 6th

First part calm and light baffling winds steering S by compass
saw a large Merchant Ship steering to the South latter part
rainy light breezes from N N E steering S so ends this day
No obs

First part Squally and rainy weather from N E and E N E
steering S by compass latter part the same so ends this day

Tuesday Nov 8th

First part pleasant with fresh trades from N E steering

S S E saw two schools of Blackfish did not lower
so ends this day

Wednesday Nov 9th

First part pleasant with light breezes from N E
steering S S E under all sail latter part the same
Spoke Bark Golconda Capt Swift went on board
watch employed in various duties so ends this day
Lat by obs 23.35 N
Long by Chron 30.50 W

Thursday Nov 10th

First part pleasant with fresh trades from E N E
steering S E by S by compass latter part the
same Spoke Bark Golconda the Captain came
on board watch employed in various duties
so ends this day
Lat by obs 22.20 N
Long by Chron 29.50 W

Friday Nov 11th

First part pleasant with fresh trades steering S S E
under all sail saw several ships latter the same
watch employed in various duties such as setting
up rigging the Coopers making a harness catch the
Carpenter's & mending box so ends this day
Lat by obs 20.13 N
Long by Chron 27.54 W
