Friday Jan 26th

First part squally weather & strong breezes from S W steering N W at 7 Am wind W heading N N W by the shortened sail double reefed latter part strong gales from W N W and N W heading N N E wore ship to the S W under close reefed Main Top sail so ends
Lat by obs 52.03 S
Long by Chron 79.50 Am W

Saturday Jan 27th

First part strong gales from W N W to S S W heading S W & S E by the wind at 10 Am wore ship to the West at 11 close reefed the Main Top sail latter part the same at 6 Pm set reefed B sail & shipped a heavy sea which stove the galley & stove at to pieces & Bulwark from the house pipe to the gangway we took in the F sail so ends this day

Sunday Jan 28th

First part cloudy weather with strong breezes from S S W steering N W at 8 Am set all sail latter part rain with strong breezes from W S W steering N W by N at 5 Pm took in the light sail bent the new Fore sail & repaired the F Top Mast Stay sail so ends this day

Long by Chron 80.20 W

Monday Jan 29th

First part thick weather with strong breezes from W to N W heading N N W & N N E by the wind under whole Top sails & courses Spoke back Morning ~~at~~ light bound to the North E W latter part the same at 6 Pm double reefed the Top sails & wore ship to the W so ends this day

First part rainy weather & strong breezes from N E N N W heading W & W S W by the wind close reefed Top sails & F sail latter more moderate set M sail double reefed N Top sail so ends this day

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from W heading N W W set all sail latter part rainy weather with light breezes from W N W heading N at 7 Pm took in the light sails so ends this day

First part pleasant with strong breezes from W heading N N W by the wind saw a plenty of finbacks latter part the same set all sail caught two Porpoises so ends this day

Thursday Feb 2nd

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from W N W heading N by the wind under all sail latter part the same employed repairing the old jib so ends this day
Lat by obs 46.18 S
Long by Chron 79.30 W

Friday Feb 3rd

First part pleasant with strong breezes from S W steering N by W by compass under all sail latter part the same at 4 Pm wind S steering N N W set Main Top sail so ends this day
Lat by obs 44.04 S
