Saturday Feb 4<sup>th</sup>

First part pleasant & calm employed in various duties latter light breezes from N N W to W N W heading N E and N by the wind under all sail Crost the 5<sup>th</sup> gattant yard & bent the sail we pumped ship & found 500 strokes in her so ends this day caught two porpoises

Sunday Feb 5<sup>th</sup>

First part pleasant with strong breezes from N W heading N N E by the wind latter part the same at 4 Pm wind W N W heading N by the wind saw a school of Blackfish so ends this day

Monday Feb 6<sup>th</sup>

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from W N W heading N by the wind employed repairing the galley & various others duties latter part the same wind N W heading N N E by the wind under all sail saw one sail so ends this day

Tuesday Feb 7<sup>th</sup>

First part cloudy weather with strong breezes from N N W heading N E at 8 Am saw the Island of Macha bearing N E dist 20 Miles wore ship to the W at 10 Am fresh gales under close reefed main Top sail & Fore sail latter part the same until 4 Pm it moderated set whole Main Top sail & courses, jib & Spanker heading S W wore ship to the N by W so ends this day

Wednesday Feb 8<sup>th</sup>

First part strong breezes from N N W heading N E at 3 Am wore ship to the W at 9 fresh gales ship under close reefed M. Top sail & F sail latter part more moderate wind W and W S W heading S S W & S at 2 Pm wore ship & steered N under short sail saw a plenty of blimp backs so ends this day

Thursday Feb 9<sup>th</sup>

First part pleasant with light breezes from N N W heading N E at 8 Am wore ship to the S W land in sight bearing E N E employed repairing the galley latter part the same at 2 Pm wore ship to the N N W at sunset took in the light sails so ends this day

Friday Feb 10<sup>th</sup>

First part pleasant with calm weather saw 3 sails employed in various duties latter part light breezes from S S W heading N W off shore at sunset land 20 miles off shortened sail for the night so ends this day

Long by Chron 74.15 W

Saturday Feb 11<sup>th</sup>

First pleasant with fresh breezes from N N W heading N E & W working to the Northward & sails in sight doing the same latter part the same at 4 Pm worked of shore & took up the light sails heading N W by W wind N N E bent the cable the Carpenter repairing the Bulwarks so ends this day
