First part pleasant with fresh breezes from S S E heading S W by the wind Steered W two hours latter part the same at 4 Pm wore Ship to the C Water employed in various duties Shortened sail for the night so ends this day

Friday March 16th

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from S S E heading N E by the wind employed repairing the Spanker latter part the same Shortened sail for the night so ends this day
Lat by obs 26.06 S
Long by Chron 71.22 W

Saturday March 17th

First part cloudy weather with fresh trades from S S E heading E latter part the same employed in various duties so ends this day
Lat by obs 25.38 S

Sunday March 18th

First part cloudy weather with strong trades from S S E heading E by the wind latter part the same hoisted up the Boats at sunset Shortened sail to a double reefed Main Top sail & fore sail so ends this day
Lat by obs 25.04 S

Monday March 19th

First part cloudy weather with fresh breezes from S S E steering E N E under all sail saw two sails Merchantman one heading S W the other steering N N E latter part wind light at sunset double reefed the Top sails & Steered N N E by compass employed in various duties so ends
Lat by obs 24.50 S

Tuesday March 20th

First part thick hazy weather with light trades heading E under all sail latter part the same at 2 Pm saw the Main land bearing E & N N E at sunset Shortened sail for the night Steered N N W under short sail employed in various duties so ends this day
Lat by obs 24.08 S
Long by Chron 71.00.50 W

Wednesday March 21th

First part pleasant with fine breezes from S S E heading E by the wind at 10 Am Steered N E and 30 miles distant bearing E latter part the same Steering N by compass employed in various duties saw two Pinbacks land at sunset 15 miles off so ends this day
Lat by obs 23.22 S
Long by Chron 70.38 W

Thursday March 22nd

First part pleasant with light trades steering N by compass employed Shortening the Mizzen Top mast latter part the same saw Spanish Fluyt back & Pinback land 30 miles distant so ends this day
Lat by obs 22.22 S
Long by Chron 70.30 W

Friday March 23rd

First part pleasant with light trades steering N E & E N W saw Black fish latter part the same saw 3 sails working to the Southward employed fitting the Mizzen Top mast at 4 Pm finished it so ends this day
