Thursday April 26<sup>th</sup>

First part squally weather fresh trades heading S by the wind  
latter part the same so ends this day. Lat by obs 19.43 S

Friday April 27<sup>th</sup>

First part pleasant with fresh trades heading E N E  
by the wind latter part the same saw one sail  
steering S W under all sail watch employed in  
various duties so ends this day. Lat by obs 20.09 S

Saturday April 28<sup>th</sup>

First part squally weather with fresh breezes from S E  
heading N E E N E by the wind latter part the same  
so ends this day. Lat by obs 19.37 S

Sunday April 29<sup>th</sup>

First part squally weather & strong breezes from S E heading  
E N E latter part wore ship to the South  
Spoke Bark Montgomerie New Bedford at 4 PM wind  
E N E heading S E Shortened sail as usual  
so ends this day. Lat by obs 19.24 S  
Long by Chron 87.40 W

Monday April 30<sup>th</sup>

First part squally weather & strong breezes from E heading  
S S E latter part the same wore ship to the N N E  
by the wind watch employed in various duties so ends  
Lat by obs 20.11 S  
Long by Chron 88.45 W

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from E S E  
heading N E by the wind latter part the same  
so ends this day. Lat by obs 19.21 S  
Long by Chron 89.20 W

May 2<sup>nd</sup>

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from E heading  
E N E by the wind latter part the same wore ship to  
the S S E Shortened sail as usual watch employed  
in various duties so ends this day. Lat by obs 18.21 S  
Long by Chron 88.59 W

May 3<sup>rd</sup>

First part squally weather with strong breezes from  
E heading S S E latter part the same saw two  
sails at 5 PM wore ship to the N N E Shortened  
sail as usual so ends this day. Lat by obs 19.50 S  
Long by Chron 89.10 W

May 4<sup>th</sup>

First part squally weather with fresh breezes from  
E heading N N E & S S E by the wind  
latter part the same so ends this day. Lat by obs 19.28 S

May 5<sup>th</sup>

First part pleasant with strong breezes from E  
steering N N E & N E by the wind latter part the  
same under double reefed so ends this day. Lat by obs 19.28 S
