First part pleasant with fresh breezes from E N E heading S E & S S E latter part the same one sail in sight so ends this day

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from E heading S S E latter moderate heading to the N N E to the wind 3 sails in sight so ends this day

Monday August 6th

First part pleasant with light from E N E heading S S E N latter part the same one sail in sight so ends this day

Lat 6 obs 18.08 S

Tuesday August 7th

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from E N E heading S E at 9 Am. saw one ship whaling we saw one of these boats along side midday we lowered & chased all day 3 Whales in sight all galled could not strike at sunset all away at dawn headed so ends this day

Wednesday August 8th

First part calm latter part the same the ship Constitution whaling we lowered did not see the Whales so ends this day

Thursday August 9th

First part pleasant with light trade heading S E latter part the same gained the Constitution so ends this day

Friday August 10th

First part pleasant with light trade heading E N E to the wind 3 sails in sight cruising about latter part heading S so ends this day

Saturday August 11th

First part pleasant with light trade heading N E C S latter part the same gained the Herby Labor so ends this day

Lat 18.58 S

Sunday August 12th

First pleasant with fresh breezes from S E heading E N E and S W latter part the same 6 sails in sight so ends this day

Monday August 13th

First part pleasant with light breezes from S E heading E N E S S W by the wind latter part the same gained Bark Hecla has taken 2 Whales since we last saw her which made him 108 barrels so ends this day

First part pleasant & calm latter light breezes from E heading S latter part the same 3 sails in sight so ends this day
