ends this day Lat 40° 44' S Long 74° 54' W

Sunday Oct 14th

First pleasant with fresh trades steering N N W
latter part the same at sunset double reefed the
top sails & heeled to the wind heading S W so ends
Lat 40° 42' N S

Monday Oct 15th

First part squally weather fresh trades steering N N W
latter part the same at sunset shortened sail
heading E by the wind so ends this day so ends
No obs

Tuesday Oct 16th

First part pleasant with fresh trades heading to
the S E latter part the same with employed
in various duties so ends this day
Lat 40° 13' S

Wednesday Oct 17th

First part pleasant with fresh trades steering to the
N latter part the same with employed in
various duties so ends this day
Lat 40° 19' miles N

Thursday Oct 18th

First part cloudy weather fresh trades working to the Wward
latter part the same spoke the Bark Batema Davis
Master so ends this day Lat 40° 37' N

Friday Oct 19th

First part cloudy weather fresh trades steering to the Wward
spoke Bark Morning Star latter part the same 2 sails
in sight shortened sail as usual so ends this day
Lat 40° 49' N

Saturday Oct 20th

First part pleasant fresh trades steering W
saw 3 pinbacks 2 bilfish ship jacks to Milwaukee
to mention caught several latter part the same
heading to the E by the wind under short sail
so ends this day Lat 40° 06' N Long 74° 25' W

Sunday Oct 21st

First part cloudy with fresh trades steering N W
at sunset heeled to the S W by the wind & shortened
sail as usual so ends this day Lat 40° 34' N Long 74° 23' W

Monday Oct 22nd

First part cloudy with strong trades at daylight
saw a school of sperm whales going to the
windward S E by S did not lower latter part
saw another school & killers among them
we lowered but with success came on board
shortened sail as usual so ends this day
Lat 40° 35' N Long 75° 30' W

Tuesday Oct 23rd

First part cloudy weather fresh trades heading S E
& W by the wind latter part the same so ends
No obs

Wednesday Oct 24th

First part pleasant with fresh trades heading
S S E & S W latter part the same one sail
in sight so ends this day Lat 40° 31' N Long 76° 00' W

Thursday Oct 25th

First part cloudy weather light breezes from S S W
heading S E & S E & S E one sail in sight latter part
the same at sunset shortened & headed to the
Wward so ends this day Lat 40° 31' N
