First part pleasant with light breezes from S heading W latter part heading S W by W employed repairing the Jib so ends this day

First part pleasant with light breezes from S from heading W S W latter part the same employed making a new Jib out of a old Jib mast studding sail so ends this day

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from S S E heading S W Chatham Island in sight bearing S W dist 50 miles latter part the same so ends this day

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from S to S S E off L on Chatham one ship to Andes latter part the same took in the light sails also took the Starboard anchor off the bow & bent the chain all ready to let go so ends this day

First part pleasant & calm latter part light breezes from S heading E S E & a strong current running N W could not get to the Island gave it up & headed to the Eastward by the wind under all sail so ends this day
