into Sul Bay & the Bark Vigilant was there with the
small pole on board we left & anchored 20 miles
further to the westward for Terrapin which we did not
get so ends this day

Thursday Nov 22th

First part To Anchor part of our men on shore
latter part all on board got underway steering N E
by compass wind S S E so ends this day

Friday Nov 23th

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from S S E
heading E latter part the same at 3 Pm more ship
to the S S W so ends this day No obs

Saturday Nov 24th

First part pleasant with light breezes from S heading W S W
at 8 Am. Steered N W & latter part the same bent a new
to job at 4 Pm saw Four Island bearing N W distant
25 miles at 7 Pm headed W S W main topsail aback
so ends this day
Lat 6 obs 00 " 16 S
Long before 89 " 37 W

Sunday Nov 25th

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from S heading
W S W at 11 Pm Towers Island dist 5 miles more ship
to the E S E so ends this day No obs

Monday Nov 26th

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from S heading
W S W & S W & W by the wind Abington Island in sight &
Towers & Aldermerle also in sight latter part the
same saw one sail employed painting boats
so ends this day
Lat 6 obs 00 " 32 N
Long before 90 " 30 W

Tuesday Nov 27th

First part pleasant with light breezes from S S E
heading S W & E by the wind with in weather clear
latter part the same so ends Lat 6 obs 00 32 N

Wednesday Nov 28th

First part pleasant with light breezes from S heading
E S E by the wind latter part the same so ends
No obs

Thursday Nov 29th

First part pleasant with light breezes from S heading
E S E by the wind latter part the same so ends
Lat 6 obs 00 " 39 S

Friday Nov 30th

First part pleasant with light breezes from S S W
& S heading W E W S W latter part the same
No obs

Saturday Dec 1st

First part pleasant with fresh breezes from S
heading W S W Chatham in sight bearing N W
steered for the E end of the Island we anchored
in a Bay to the leeward of the Island for Terrapin
so ends this day
Lat 6 obs 00 " 44 S
Long 89 " 20 W

Sunday Dec 2nd

First part To Anchor all hands on shore after
Terrapin latter part returned with ten

Monday Dec 3rd

To Anchor all hands employed getting of Terrapin
latter part the same

Tuesday Dec 4th

To Anchor pleasant all hands employed Terrapin
one half on shore all the time the others getting them
on board latter part the same so ends this day
