First part cloudy weather with strong breezes from S E head E N E & S S W by this wind latter part Steered N W at 4 PM hauled up N N W employed boiling turned up 3 1/2 barrels at sunset heading E N E took in the light sails so ends this day

Tuesday Feb 5th

First part pleasant with strong breezes from S E heading S S W & E N E by the wind gained the Morning Star & Norton 42 months 2100 Sperm latter part the same so ends this day

Wednesday Feb 6th

First part cloudy weather strong breezes from S steering N E N W by the wind latter part the same at sunset took in the light sails and heaved to the wind S S W so ends this day
