 & spent the day they saw Whales two days ago so ends
 Lat by obs 1.18 N

Saturday June 29th
 First part pleasant with fresh trades steering N by compass
 latter part by the wind to the Eward one sail in sight
 employed in various so ends this day Lat by obs 1.29 N
 Long by Chron 84.40 W

Sunday June 30th
 First part pleasant with fresh breezes from S heading
 E S E by the wind at 6 am were ship to the W S W
 saw two sails heading to the Eward latter part the same
 so ends this day Lat by obs 1.36 N

Monday July 1st
 First part pleasant with fresh trades heading S E by the
 wind latter part the same saw two sails heading to the Eward
 two men sick employed in various duties so ends this
 day Lat by obs 1.43 N

Tuesday July 2nd
 First part rain with fresh breezes from S heading
 S E latter part pleasant at night to in the light
 sails so ends this day Lat by obs 1.47 N
 Long by Chron 83.09 W

Wednesday July 3rd
 First part cloudy weather fresh trades heading E S E
 by the wind latter part the same so ends this day
 No obs

Thursday July 4th
 First part pleasant with fresh trades heading E S E by the
 wind saw 3 sails latter part the same spoke B Vigilant
 has to him 160 barrels in June we also spoke the Active
 100 barrels so ends this day Lat by obs 00.06 N

Friday July 5th
 First part pleasant with fresh trades heading E
 by the wind saw the land bearing N E and E
 latter part the same saw 3 sails at sunset spoke
 the B Roscoe 300 sperm & 60 hump back
 got one to day the land dist 15 miles plenty of
 humpbacks around so ends this day Lat by obs 00.16 S

Saturday July 6th
 First part pleasant with fresh trades steering N E
 down the coast at sunset anchored of
 Esmeraldas along side the Trident so ends this
 day Lat by obs 00.42 N

Sunday July 7th
 First to anchor got under way sailed aback the Boat
 went in shore after Humpbacks no success
 set go anchor at 2 PM again Boats on board
 so ends this day

Monday July 8th
 To anchor fresh trades & pleasant weather 3 Boats off
 trying to catch a humpback no success latter part the
 same two sails anchored to day & the Bark
 Ripple got a small Whale so ends this day

Tuesday July 9th
 To anchor fine weather & fresh trades off for Whales
 as usual could not strike latter part the same
 the Bark Roscoe got a small Whale so ends this
 day
