 To Anchor fresh trades fine weather chasing Humpbacks
 could not strike latter part the same 6 sails to
 Anchor so ends this day

Thursday July 11th
 To Anchor fine weather fresh trades saw several Humpbacks
 could not strike two sharks got underway latter part the
 same so ends this day

Friday July 12th
 First part to anchor fine weather fresh trades looking
 for Humpbacks latter part the same so ends

Saturday July 13th
 First part to anchor fine weather lowered the Boats
 saw nothing latter part got underway & run to
 Esmeraldas & let go anchor again saw two Humpbacks
 off shore did not however be kept a sick man on shore
 and that we got in Cadiz so ends this day

Sunday July 14th
 To Anchor off Esmeraldas saw one Humpback chased
 to the windward took a Bone Shark to the Ship & saved
 his liver latter part trading with the Spaniards so ends

Monday July 15th
 First part got underway steered to the NE 20 miles
 latter the same took a Bone Shark & lost him
 at 7 PM Anchored again saw two Humpbacks
 just at night did not lose so ends this day

Tuesday July 16th
 To Anchor fine weather strong trades at 8 AM got
 underway saw several Humpback very shy could
 not strike latter part the same at 4 PM headed W by
 the wind stowed the Anchor & cable at sunset
 took in the light sails so ends this day

Wednesday July 17th
 First part pleasant with fresh trades heading W by S by the wind
 saw one School of Fish lowered one Boat missed two could
 not get fast latter wind & weather the same saw one Sail
 employed in various day duties so ends this day
 Lat by obs 02.03 N

Thursday July 18th
 First part pleasant with strong trades heading W by S
 Spoke Ship Hesper 450 barrels Spinn latter part the
 same gaming with the Hesper so ends this day
 Lat by obs 2.43 N
 Long by Chron 81.30 W

Friday July 19th
 First part pleasant with strong trades heading W by S
 by the wind Spoke Ship Hesper sold him an old
 Boat latter part the same at 6 PM wore Spinn
 to the S E by S by the wind under all sail so ends
 Lat by obs 3.01 N

Saturday July 20th
 First part pleasant with fresh trades heading S E
 by the wind the Hesper in sight latter part the same
 so ends this day
 Lat by obs 2.12 N
 Long by Chron 81.06 W

Sunday July 21th
 First part pleasant with fresh trades heading S E
 by the wind saw the land bearing E & S E distant
 25 miles at latter part wore Spinn to the W N W
 by the wind saw two Humpbacks so ends this day
 Lat by obs 00.46 N

Monday July 22th
 First part squally weather fresh trades heading to
 the W ward latter part the same so ends this day
 Lat by obs 1.12 N

Tuesday July 23th
 First part squally weather fresh trades heading S E
 by the wind latter part the same employed Smith
 so ends this day
 Lat by obs 1.30 N
 Long by Chron 83.00 W
