

Wednesday July 24th

First part pleasant with fresh trades heading S by S
latter part more ship to the W at 6 Pm made ship to
the S & one sail in sight watch employed in
various duties so ends this day Lat by obs 1..35 N

Thursday July 25th

First part pleasant with fresh trades heading S by S
of the wind two sails in sight heading to the S & E
latter part the same at sunset the Bos Stepp
stood listening to hear what the officers had to say
& I told him he had better go away & he told me
to mind my own business for which I took him
by the arm & led him up for which the Captain
gave me a severe scolding & stated that I was an
mean man in fact he had caused a deal of trouble
so ends this day Lat by obs 1..02 N

Friday July 26th

First part squally with fresh trades heading to the Westward
latter part the same saw two sails heading to the East
employed in various duties so ends this day No obs

Saturday July 27th

First part rainy weather fresh trades steering E by compass
latter part the same so ends this day No obs

Sunday July 28th

First part cloudy sometimes fresh trades steering E N & E
by compass latter part the same at 2 Pm saw Hump
& back cow & calf the S & struck the calf the rest of us
the cow & killed the calf we was fast to the cow
till dark & cut the calf we set go in hoisting strop
it was so going the hook would not hold so ends
Lat by obs 00..30 N

Monday July 29th

First part fine weather fresh trades steering E by compass
latter part the same steering E N & E under all sail
Saw a Brigg steering to the W watch employed in
repairing damaged that took place yesterday so ends
Lat by obs 00..32 N
Long by chron 81..05 W

Tuesday July 30th

First part cloudy with strong trades steering E N & E
by compass at 7 Am made the Main Land ahead latter part
the same at 2 Pm lowered two Boats for a cow &
calf struck to the S Boat at 4 Pm took the cow to the
Ship & let go anchor the Whale sunk but we have
his small up & let him hang one ship to anchor
of shore hailing so ends this day No obs

Wednesday July 31th

First part pleasant with calm weather so anchor at
daylight began to cut finished at 11 Am latter
part looking up deck no whales in sight one sail off
and on so ends this day

Thursday July August 1st

First part pleasant with fresh trades so anchor
3 Boats in shore whaling the Boat struck at 8 Pm
took the cow to the ship & cut her in so ends

Friday August 2nd

So anchor fine weather chasing whale could not
strike 4 sails in sight one hailing latter part
the same no whales in the Bay so ends this day

Saturday August 3rd

So anchor fine weather no whales employed
hailing latter part the same so ends this day

Sunday August 4th

So anchor fine weather no whales latter part
the same Boats of looking for whales did not
see any so ends this day
