To Anchor fine weather looking for Whales not
any in the Bay latter part began to blow down in the
mid in the day so ends this day

Tuesday August 4th

To Anchor fine weather & calm 2 Boats of Saw one
Whale could not strike employed stows down
latter part the same stowed down 70 barrels of Humpback
and 46 barrels of Sperm at sunset decks all clear
so ends this day

Wednesday August 5th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades chased one
Whale in company with the Ripple could not strike
latter part came on board so ends this day

Thursday August 6th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades struck to the S B
Cove & cut the line came on board got under way
& worked to the windward & let go Anchor again so ends

Friday August 7th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades saw cow & calf
struck to the Waist Boat & killed the calf the cow
run us off shore 15 miles at 4 Pm took her along side
began to cut did not finish the Sharks eat her about
one third up so ends this day

Saturday August 8th

First part fine weather began to cut at 8 Am
finished cutting at 12 Pm for the store could not
quit the Bay stood off began to hail so ends this day

Sunday August 9th

First part pleasant with fresh trades at 2 Am wore ship
in shore at all sail at 7 Am finished hoisting land
in sight latter the same saw 2 sails under way to Anchor
at 2 Pm let go Anchor in 5 fathoms of water saw one Whale
so ends this day

Monday August 10th

First part To Anchor fine weather saw one Whale
could not strike latter came on board no Whales
around repaired the Waist Boat so ends this day

Tuesday August 11th

First part To Anchor fine weather fresh trades saw no
Whales latter part the same got a small Bone Shark to the
Waist Boat so ends this day

Wednesday August 12th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades no Whales in sight
latter part the same Boats came on board so ends this
day

Thursday August 13th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades Boats of Saw two
could not strike repaired the L Boat latter part all on
board so ends this day

Friday August 14th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades 4 Boats of Saw
several Whales could not strike 2 sails in sight
off & on latter all hands on board so ends this day

Saturday August 15th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades 3 Boats off
lookings for Whales did not see any latter part the
same got 3000 Oranges from Shore so ends

Sunday August 16th

To Anchor fine weather light trades at 1 Am
got the ship under way two Boats off saw Whales
struck to the L Boat the Sions drew & lost the Wha
no Boat to assist me they were chasing Whales
off shore latter part no Whales around so
ends this day
