

Monday August 19th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades lowered 3 Boats
Struck to the L Boat we killed the Whale and sunk her
the Sharks eat the craft out of her before the Ship
could get to her the W Boat got stove we took her in
& put another in her place latter part no Whales
at 2 Pm Anchored the Captain & third mate
had some words together So ends this day

Tuesday August 20th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades the Captain &
third mate Mr Stanton went on shore Mr Stanton
wanted his discharge the Captain told him that he
had better stay by the Ship but he refused to do so
& said that he could not stay any longer so he was
discharged as he wished I saw Whales struck to the
S B & took her along side Mr Stanton prother deserted
I think that the third mate enticed him off
latter part cutting at 3 Pm finished So ends this day

Wednesday August 21

To Anchor fine weather Saw two whales could not
strike latter part began to hail so ends this day

Thursday August 22

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades Saw one cow
& calf could not strike repaired the S Boat which
got stove the last Whale finished boiling Saw
one Whale could not strike Ship got underway
Shake bark Spinnaker 700 barrels at 5 Pm let go &
Anchored in shore So ends this day

Friday August 23th

To Anchor fine weather strong trades Saw one Whale
could not strike the Captain went on shore to Ship
some men got one latter all hands on board So ends this
day

Saturday August 24th

To Anchor fine weather light trades saw cow & calf struck
to the L B & got her along side the ship heavy he drew
the craft out of her so we lost all latter & all hands on
board So ends this day

Sunday August 25th

To Anchor fine weather strong breezes no Whales in shore
latter part the same Boats came on board one ship in sight
working to the Southward under all sail So ends this day

Monday August 26th

To Anchor fine strong trades boats of saw several Whales
no cows & calves latter part came on board So ends

Tuesday August 27th

To Anchor fine weather & fresh trades got underway
with the ship Saw several Whales of shore could not
strike latter part working to the windward at 6 Pm
Anchored off shore So ends this day

Wednesday August 28th

To Anchor sent 4 Boats off for W live to the windward
two to the leeward struck to the L Boat & drew
Saw another & struck to the L Boat Boats to
the windward also struck the B Boat run him
to the windward & drew the Ship had no men
to get underway with so we lost all & left them
for the Sharks So ends this day

Thursday August 29th

To Anchor off the garden 3 Boats off saw few Whales
could not strike latter part all on board Europe
boiling So ends this day

Friday August 30th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades 3 Boats off struck
to the L Boat the S Boat struck the cow the
Boat steers killed the calf with his sword & the cow
drew the craft latter part struck to the L Boat again
& lost her the Ship got underway at sunset let
go again So ends this day
