Sunday Sept 1st

To Anchor fine weather saw several Whales could not strike latter part the same got underway & went into Sea for water & fruit at 6 Pm. Let go Anchor the Bark John A Parker was there so ends this day

Monday Sept 2nd

To Anchor sent a raft on shore for water also stowing down oil finished stowing oil latter part the same so ends this day

Tuesday Sept 3rd

To Anchor fine weather getting of Water latter part the same got the raft & stowed it away the Captain & Lady on shore so ends this day

Wednesday Sept 4th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades Boatting of oranges plantain latter part the same got 5500 oranges 30 bunches of Bananas & plantain so ends this day

Thursday Sept 5th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades employed hanging up pumpkins plantain bananas latter part the same the John Parker got underway so ends this day

Friday Sept 6th

To Anchor fine weather light trades the Captain on shore trying to ship one man but he could not one man left but he did not belong to the ship but he agreed to go one boy came on board wanted to go with us the Captain made a bargain with him to go all ready for sea so ends this day

Saturday Sept 7th

To Anchor off Sea at 7 Am got underway two Boats off struck to the L Boat latter part cutting at 12 Pm finished let go Anchor so ends this day

Sunday Sept 8th

To Anchor Boats of Whaling struck to the L Boat latter took her along side finished cutting at 4 Pm so ends

Monday Sept 9th

To Anchor got underway & worked to the windward saw two Whales could not strike latter part came on board began to boil so ends this day

Tuesday Sept 10th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades got underway covered two Boats struck to the L Boat latter part cutting finished at sunset finished boiling the two first Whales so ends this day

Wednesday Sept 11th

To Anchor Boats of no Whales latter part came on board began to boil so ends this day

Thursday Sept 12th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades Boats of no Whales The Bark Vigilant came in & anchored latter the same Boats on board employed stowing down at sunset finished clear racks stowed 55 barrels the three Whales so ends this day

Friday Sept 13th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades covered 4 Boats struck to the L Boat latter ship got underway at 3 Pm took the Whale along side let him lay over night the Europa Boats & Vigilant Boats were also done didn't strike so ends this day
