& garbed so ends this day

Monday March 17th

First part fine weather fresh breezes from W
Steering S E by compass latter part the same
employed in various duties Massapequa bearing
S W dist 2 5 miles so ends this day

Tuesday March 18th

First part fine weather fresh breezes from W steering
S E by compass latter part the same so ends this day

Wednesday March 19th

First part fresh breezes with rain from N W steering
S E by compass latter part calm at 5 Pm fresh breezes from
S E heading N E by compass wind double reefed the
top sails employed in breaking out spoochs & heads
so ends this day

First part light breezes from S W steering S E
S E by compass employed setting up spoochs
for March latter part the same so ends this day

so ends this day

First part fine weather strong breezes from S heading
S E by the wind made all sail latter part the
same employed setting casks so ends this day

Tuesday March 25th

First part thick weather & calm at 8 Am clear saw
the land to the E dist 15 miles latter part the same
at 2 Pm fresh breezes from S S W heading S E by
compass harbor saw 3 sails bound out a 2 bound
in at 5 Pm stood off shore by the wind employed
in various duties so ends this day

Wednesday March 26th

First part fine weather light breezes from S heading
for Salcamano harbor latter part the same at 5 Pm
set go anchor so ends this day

Thursday March 27th

To anchor fine weather sending Sperm oil home
by the Morning Star latter part the same
so ends this day
