First part fine weather fresh trades steering N by compass latter part the same employed making Spungarn so ends this day

Lat by obs 11.59 S

Thursday June 26th

First part fine fresh trades steering N by compass latter part the same at 5 PM by the wind E N E took in the light sails so ends this day

Lat by obs 2.43 S

Friday June 27th

First part fine weather light trades steering N by compass at 9 AM saw Woods Island bearing N at 2 PM steered N W at 4 steered N at sunset by the wind the Main Top sail aback saw Charles Island bearing N by W so ends this day

Lat by obs 1.38 S

Long by Chron 91.40 W

Saturday June 28th

First part fine weather fresh trades cruising about Charles Island latter part spoke Galapagos taken one Whale since leave the fishes ground two boats went in fishing spoke the Merlin & gannet so ends this day

Sunday June 29th

First part fine weather fresh trades off 8 AM the Island garrison the Merlin all day latter part the same so ends this day

Monday June 30th

First part cloudy weather fresh trades off 8 AM Charles Island at 4 PM split the fib & bent the new one latter repairing the old fib so ends

Tuesday July 1st 1862

First part cloudy weather fresh trades off 8 AM Charles Island stood off 6 hours in shore

14 hours strong current running S W latter part the same employed in various duties so ends this day

Wednesday July 2nd

First part cloudy weather fresh trades heading E by the wind paced to the windward of Charles Island this 15 miles latter part the same at 4 PM the Island bore N W took in the light sails the Carpenter repairing an old boat so ends this day

Thursday July 3rd

First part fine weather light trades cruising about Charles Island latter part the same the Carpenter repairing an old boat shortened sail Main Top aback so ends this day

Friday July 4th

First part fine weather light trades from S E steering N by compass Charles Island dist. 10 miles latter part the same at 6 PM the Island bearing S S E dist. 6 miles wind light & E N E heading N so ends this day
