Sunday Sept 14th

First part fine weather got underway heading N.W. under short sail the Norman also got clear latter part nothing a doing so ends this day

Monday Sept 15th

First part cloudy weather fresh trades heading N.W. latter part the same all hands stowing Anchors & cable & cutting gear away so ends this day

First part cloudy weather fresh trades heading S.S.W. latter part the same employed Shaking Flumpleback cask & various other duties hoisted a new line to the W Boat so ends this day

Wednesday Sept 17th

First part fine weather fresh trades heading E.S.E. & W.S.W. by the wind latter part the same employed cleaning Flumpleback cask so ends this day

Thursday Sept 18th

First part fine weather steering to the Wward latter part the same saw one sail employed washing ship at sunset by the wind E.S.E. so ends this day

Friday Sept 19th

First part fine weather light trades heading S.S.W. by the wind latter part steering to the Wward employed washing ship at 10 P.M. a man went aboard we got him again at night by the wind heading E.N.E.

Saturday Sept 20th

First part fine weather strong trades S.S.W. at 1 P.M. saw something that looked like sperm whales going quick to the N.E. chased but could not catch them at 10 A.M. they went out of sight latter part the same chased on but could not see them again at 1 P.M. by the wind S.S.W. at 4 P.M. wore ship to the E.N.E. shortened sail for the night so two men got the Revere ague so ends this day
