Wednesday Nov 5th

To Anchor fine weather one watch liberty latter part the Starboard watch came on board the other went up to the town so ends this day

Thursday Nov 6th

To Anchor fine weather nothing doing latter part the same so ends this day

Friday Nov 7th

To Anchor fine weather latter part the same the watch came from town so we are all on board but the Capt & family two sailors that he shipped to day so ends this day

Saturday Nov 8th

To Anchor fine weather fresh trades all hands on board latter part the same took on board three passengers for Paita so ends this day

Sunday Nov 9th

First part pleasant wind S W got underway heading off shore W N W of the wind latter part the same in shore S E Stowed the Starboard Anchor so ends this day

Monday Nov 10th

First part fine weather fresh trades working to Paita latter part the same so ends this day

Tuesday Nov 11th

First part fine weather strong trades heading S W off shore latter part heading S E in shore so ends this day

Wednesday Nov 12th

First part fine weather strong trades heading S W & W S in the off shore track latter part S E in shore track so ends this day

Thursday Nov 13th

First part fine weather fresh trades heading for Paita we were on the the leeward side of the Bay at 6 Am steered for Paita head as we thought but got deceived in the land we then until 1 Pm we found ourselves off Cape Blanco so we went to beating again so ends this day
Lat 6° 04' 13" S

Friday Nov 14th

First part fine weather fresh trades beating to the South latter part the same at 5 Pm thought we saw Paita head bearing S E dist 20 miles very light winds
Lat 6° 04' 28" S

Saturday Nov 15th

First part fine weather fresh trades at 8 Am the boat went on shore the Capt & passengers latter part came on board with the letters off & on through the night so ends

Sunday Nov 16th

First part fine weather light trades Capt & family went on shore latter part off & on so ends this day

Monday Nov 17th

First part fine weather fresh trades off & on at Paita at 10 Am sent the boat in for the Captain at 11 came on board headed W S W of the wind under all sail saw a ship heading for Paita Stowed the Starboard Anchor & cable Shipped one man Blacksmith so ends this day

Tuesday Nov 18th

First part fine weather trades heading S S W of the wind latter part the same employed painting boats so ends

First part fine fresh trades heading S S W of the wind latter part the same employed in various duties so ends this day
