First part fine weather fresh breezes from S heading E N E saw the Island Juan Fernandez bearing E latter part the same gunning with that E. Canoe so ends this day

Sunday March 8th

First part fine weather fresh breezes from S heading W S W & E S E by the wind saw 3 Sails spoke the Ship Europa for Sandwich Island so ends this day

Lat by obs 33.32 S

Monday March 9th

First part strong breezes from S heading Eward latter part delivering Shakes on Board the Collist E. Canoe we let her 200 barrels & some hoops & one pipe of Bread containing 717 pounds at 11 Pm closed business & had a gun firing bearing S S W dist 12 miles so ends

Tuesday March 10th

First part fine weather strong breezes beating up to Juan after fish latter part the same at 3 Pm sent two Boats in got some fish at 4 Pm head W S W by the wind so ends this day

Wednesday March 11th

First part cloudy weather steering W by compass Massapuro in sight bearing W S W latter part the same at 4 Pm by the wind S W double reefed so ends this day

Thursday March 12th

First part fine weather light breezes from E N E cruising N W of Massapuro dist 25 miles so ends this day gunning with the Lancer 9 Sails in sight

Around Massapuro in 1833 Western of Swift Master

Friday March 13th

First part light breezes from E N E cruising about W N W of the Island latter part the same 9 Sails in sight so ends this day

Saturday March 14th

First part fine weather strong breezes from S heading S S W saw a large Spinn Whale going S E did not lower saw him three times latter more moderate so spoke & gained the Active so ends

Sunday March 15th

First part strong breezes from S heading S S W by the wind gained the Vigilant & E Scott latter part the same so ends this day

Monday March 16th

First part fresh breezes from S S E heading W S W & S W by the wind latter part the same wore Ship heading E by N 5 Sails in sight so ends this day

Lat by obs 34.06 S

Tuesday March 17th

First part cloudy weather strong breezes from S S E heading E by N by the wind latter part the same saw 5 Sails Massapuro bearing S E dist 30 miles bent a new F Top sail so ends this day

Lat by obs 33.36 S

Wednesday March 18th

First part strong breezes from S heading E N E & S S W & S W by the wind saw several Ships latter part the same so ends this day

Thursday March 19th

First part fine weather strong breezes from S S E heading E by N by the wind latter part the same Juan bearing E S E dist 30 miles so ends this day
