so ends this day four ships after fish besides
ourselves

Sunday March 22nd

First part clear strong breezes from S S W heading around
Juan saw humpback toward got most on latter part the
same saw the Active cutting so ends this day

Monday March 23rd

First part fine weather strong breezes from S S E
heading E by S by the wind latter part the same bent new
Main Top Sail Juan in sight bearing S W at 5 saw a large
Merchantman steering N W by compass so ends this
day

by the wind latter part the same so ends this day

First part fine weather light baffling winds steering
S S E by compass saw two sails one we called the Gypsy
latter part the same heading S E by the wind so ends this day
Lat by obs 34. 16 S

Friday March 27th

First part fine weather light breezes from S heading E S E
by the wind gained the Scott & Crescent latter part the
same working to the S so ends this day

Lat by obs 34. 49 S

Saturday March 28th

First part fresh breezes from S heading E S E & W S W
by the wind latter part the same saw 3 sail heading East
so ends this day

Lat by obs 35. 09 S

Sunday March 29th

First part thick fog light breezes from S S W heading S E
& S E by E by the wind latter part the same at 3 Pm made
the Island stand in within a half mile wore ship off shore
so ends this day

Lat by obs 36. 01 S

Monday March 30th

First part thick fog calm weather steering Sand
S S E by compass latter part the same
Lat by obs 36. 13 S

Tuesday March 31st

First part thick fog wind N steering Island
3 miles off at 9 Am went into Salcedo Bay
thick fog could not see the land we worked our way
up the Bay at 3 Pm let go anchor in 6 fathoms
we let go the small anchor at 12 at night a fresh gale
from N let go the large anchor & lay through the
night so ends this day
