stowing down sperm oil we took 4906 from the
Bark Helen Snow so ends this day
Marks *LD* No. 1. to 24

Sunday April 19th

To Anchor pleasant latter part the same

Monday April 20th

First part To Anchor Bark Rosee alongside
we took 7894 gallons of Sperm oil Marks Rosee
No. 1 to 40 latter part stowing down so ends this day

Tuesday April 21th

To Anchor fine weather stowing down in after hold
latter part the same

Wednesday April 22th

To Anchor fine weather South wind took 1141 gallons
of Blumback oil from N. S. Perkins Marks *P*
latter part stowing down so ends this day

Thursday April 23th

To Anchor fine weather sold on Boat Anchor one
trip to the Vigilant latter part got same 45
barrels on shore & casks making room for oil so ends

To Anchor fine weather light breezes from South
took from Bark Endeavor 4178 gallons of Sperm
oil latter part stowing down in after hold so ends
this day Marks *A A*

Saturday April 25th

To Anchor employed stowing down oil & clearing
decks selling salt casks sold a lot of old head by
& hoops sold to the Vigilant 3233 pounds of
bread so ends this day

Sunday April 26th

To Anchor fine weather latter part wind N blowing
strong so ends this day

Monday April 27th

To Anchor fine weather took the Passace sent new
shocks and there on deck put cordage & towline iron
hoops one Boat Anchor so ends this day

Tuesday April 28th

To Anchor fine weather got our wood Potatoes
20 barrells of Beef 12 barrells of Flour so ends

Wednesday April 29th

To Anchor fine weather light breezes from
N stowing away provisions clearing decks
also got our water 170 barrells so ends this day

Thursday April 30th

To Anchor fine weather wind Northward all
hands on board all ready for sea latter part took
our Anchor & hauled out of the fleet of ships
so ends this day
