

- S 11 Commences with strong winds from the S saw four sails all bound to the windward backed ship twice in the course of the day all well and so ends the day
- S 12 Commences with strong winds from the S saw four sails bound to the raised whales and run off but made them out to be humpbacks all well so ends the day
- No 13 Commences with stiff breeze from the S and saw four sails all on the larboard tack with us set up our lee rigging and backed all well so ends the day
- J 14 Commences with fine weather wind abeam arrived at 4 o'clock at the long 20° 35' and saw the Robert Edwards off the lee beam all well so ends the day
- W 15 Commences with fine weather light wind on the larboard beam course S S W saw the Robert Edwards on the lee and exchanged signals with her by S W by W at dark all well so ends the day
- J 16 Commences with fine weather strong breeze on the larboard quarter saw breeches to the windward and where ship made them to be humpbacks all well so ends the day
- J 17 Commences with fine weather S E Trade wind saw humpbacks to the windward and two sails all well so ends the day
- S 18 Commences with fine weather winds the same raised a large sperm whale on the weather bow and lowered but did not strike saw him last at 5 o'clock 8 or 5 miles off on the weather bow saw two sails at dusk all well so ends the day
- S 19 light winds from the S E steering S W saw finbacks and two sails spoke the French Barge bound Calcutta all well so ends the day
- No 20 Strong winds from the S E steering W S W under double reefed topsails saw finbacks and four sails all well so ends the day
- J 21 light winds from the S E steering S W with nothing in sight but finbacks all well so ends the day

- W 22 good breeze from the S E steering W S W Lat 18° 55' S Long 82° 35' W saw two sails and finbacks raised sperm whales at half past 4 going to the windward fast and did not lower all well so ends the day took in sail
- J 23 Light winds the same steering different courses saw breeches off the lee beam and run off but saw no more of them saw three sails on course at the day took in sail and stood quarter watches so ends the day
- J 24 Light winds the same saw one sail and some finbacks all well so ends the day
- S 25 Light winds the same nothing in sight but finbacks all well so ends the day
- S 26 fine light winds saw three sails and plenty of finbacks all well so ends the day
- No 27 Strong breeze and rain double reefed the topsails and saw three sails all well so ends the day
- J 28 Fine strong breeze nothing in sight but fin and humpbacks all well so ends the day
- W 28 Fine with strong breeze nothing in sight but finback saw breeches to the windward all well
- J 29 Strong breeze with rain nothing in sight but fin and humpbacks all well so ends the day
- J 31 Strong breeze with rain saw three sails and finbacks all well so ends the day
- S 1 September 1st Commences with strong breeze saw nothing but humpbacks so lower up for 100 lbs sperm all well so ends the day
- S 2 Fine with light winds saw two sails and finbacks all well so ends the day
- No 3 Fine with dead calm one sail in sight lowered for a sulphur bottom whale but did not strike all well so ends the day
- J 4 Strong breeze with rain saw finback and three sails all well so ends the day
- W 5 Strong breeze with rain double reefed the top sailed and saw five sails and one finback so ends the day
