

10 D 25 Commences with strong breeze and increased to moderate gale stored down our pile and sail and some barrels in the weather yarder and clocked off the main hatchway.

W 26 Commences with strong gale washed off the deck in the morning and saw nothing through the

D 27 Commences with strong breeze and died away to a light one saw nothing but finbacks stood whole watches at night

D 28 Commences with good breeze with fog and rain with nothing in sight running S E

S 29 Commences with strong breeze with fog and rain saw nothing running S E

S 30 Commences with strong gale from the N W run off S E and took in sail and hove to at eight o'clock

W 31 Commences with strong breeze from the N W running S E with nothing in sight a man fell overboard but made out to catch him and so ends the last day of 1849

January first 1850

D 1 Commences with strong breeze from the N W strong S E the wind increased to a heavy gale took in sail and hove to at half past one P M

W 2 Commences with light breeze and heavy sea kept off S E continues the same through the day

D 3 Commences with light saw a sail on the weather beam saw nothing in sight through the day

D 4 Commences with strong breeze nothing in sight but finbacks so ends the day

S 5 Commences with light breeze saw finbacks

S 6 Commences with strong breeze but increased to a gale hove to at ten o'clock and saw a large water spout wind lulled and we kept off S E and S again and with sail at one P M a plenty of fog and rain took in sail and stood quarter watch

W 7 Commences with moderate gale from the N W laid to through the day with nothing in sight

D 8 Commences with moderate gale from the N W laid to until one P M and made sail and run off S E

S 20 Commences with strong breeze saw a plenty of
finbacks and took in sail and hove to at one P M

W 22 Commences with strong gale and laid to through the day
with nothing in sight but finbacks

D 23 Commences with strong breeze and increased to
a moderate gale with fog and rain

W 24 Commences with light breeze and continues so through
the day caught a porpoise and saw finbacks
