

June 30 Commences with good breeze
 several finbacks and gained a
 night with the Florida and
 Carolina of new Bedford left the
 21 mths put 1300 whale and 70 S
 the Florida is a sailing

J 31 Commences with strong breeze with
 and increased to a heavy gale at noon
 with heavy squalls of wind and rain
 both the other ships in sight in the
 morning but lost sight of them in
 course of the day

S June 1 1850 Commences with heavy gale
 and continues so through the day with
 nothing in sight but one sail

S 2 Commences with strong double reefed
 topsail breeze with nothing in
 sight but flying fish and birds

M 3 This day begins as usual with strong
 breeze so that we are under reefed top
 sails all day with nothing in sight as
 usual except finbacks but as men
 raised a noise today like sperm whale
 but we could not make out anything
 but sea breaks so we gave it up

J 4 This day is an exception for it begins
 with light breeze and dies away calm
 at night caught an albicore today the
 first one the we have taken this voyage
 saw some finbacks and put up a barrel
 of beef that struck the first one
 that we have found yet

W 5 This day begins with a light pleasant
 breeze in the morning but increased to
 a strong one at noon saw something that
 they called a school of dolphins after breakfast
 but they got out of sight before we
 made them out saw several finbacks

Th 6 This day we had a strong breeze saw
 a ship on the weather bow at sunrise
 and raised a large school of finbacks
 and blackfish at noon and were round
 twice to look at them when the ship
 too windward kept off for us and we
 thought it was the South Carolina
 and gained with her the rest of the day

13
 This day begins with a strong breeze
 with the South Carolina close to
 our off and gained with her after
 dinner untill three o'clock when we
 raised sperm whale and lowered and
 left her had our boat and struck
 a whale and got him and our old man
 aboard and got another as they came to
 windward this is the Captains day
 raised by the Cooper Sat Long

S 8 This day we had good breeze with
 heavy sea cut in our whale and
 cleared away the lead in the forenoon
 and started the waker and run
 off and spoke the S C and
 gained in the afternoon and got our
 boat for left her got his whale
 with our boat

S 9 This day we had strong breeze with
 rain squalls got through trying out
 at noon and furled the fore and
 mastsails after dinner and lowered
 the S C still in sight on the lee

That you did that the

M 10 This day we had strong breeze with
 nothing in sight in the fore part but we
 raised two two ships on the weather beam
 and they run off at night but come to both the
 windward of us to gain in the morning

J 11 This day we had strong breeze and spoke
 the Florida and the Bager and gained all
 day but saw nothing more so ended the day

W 12 This day we had a good breeze with the
 Florida and Bager in sight spoke the
 Bager and let her have two casks of
 food and stowed down our oil saw
 nothing in sight but finbacks the whale
 showed down 44 barrels

J 13 This day we had a good breeze saw some
 finbacks and raised the Florida on our
 lee and run off and spoke her and gained
 all day and saw nothing

J 14 This day we had a strong breeze and
 run off to the off for we are bound for
 Port and the Florida with us she was in
 sight all day on the Starboard beam and
 whole watches at night
