

M 8 This day we had a strong breeze with squalls of rain in the forenoon and double reefed the fore and main topsails in the forenoon and set up the larboard foretop sail rigging. Saw a large lone shark at four o'clock nothing more seen to day.

J 9 This day we had a strong breeze so that we ran under double reefed top sails all a day with nothing in sight.

W 11 This day we had a steady breeze in the morning we turned the reefs out and set top gallant sails but took them in at four o'clock it was squally with rain leak out water in the forenoon saw nothing.

J 11 This day we had a steady breeze all day with nothing in sight.

J 12 This day we had a strong breeze with nothing in sight took in the fore and main top gallant sails in the afternoon.

S 13 This day we had a good breeze through the day and took in the top gallant sails in the night wet hold after dinner saw nothing.

S 14 This day we had a strong breeze all day double reefed the top sails after breakfast saw nothing to day.

M 15 This day we had a strong breeze in the quarter with squalls all day took in the main sail at night saw nothing but a breeze at day light steering the starboard.

J 16 This day we had a strong breeze all day set the main sail in the morning saw two finbacks in course of the day.

W 17 This day is the same as the rest strong breeze with heavy squalls of wind and rain with nothing in sight but blue sky.

J 18 This day is an exception from the common rule for it was moderate in the morning and the wind set all sails but had a squall at four and took in top gallant sails but set the main again after dinner saw nothing.

S 19 This day we had a strong breeze with squalls and rain we are just out of the bay steering W by N saw nothing.

S 20 This day we had a moderate blow from the S E steering at it took in the main top gallant at daylight and double reefed the top sails after dinner and wet hold and broke out water and killed a goose and two dozen chickens for tomorrow saw nothing.

S 21 This day we had a strong breeze with some rain run to the S W all day under double reefed top sails with nothing in sight.

M 22 This day we had a good breeze all day turned the reefs out of the top sail and set the main top gallant sail unless the foretop sail stay sails and mended it and bent it again. Sailed the day with nothing in sight.

J 23 This day we had a good breeze and clear took in sails and hove to at night for fear of the land saw nothing but a lone finback.

W 24 This day we had a moderate gale in the morning made sail at daylight and steered W by South and raised the north end of Madagascan at ten o'clock and had it in sight all day running with the wind East.

J 25 This day we had a light breeze in the forenoon and a calm after dinner the hold all night saw sparks and felt a plenty of land.

J 26 This day we had a calm all day with two sails in sight one at each beam saw a plenty of fish and lowered for a turtle with no luck.

S 27 This day we had a good breeze with a close hauled until four o'clock when it died away calm and remained as still till ten in the night saw nothing but fish.

S 28 This day we had a strong breeze and double reefed the top sails in the morning and turned them out at night saw nothing.

M 29 This day we had all sorts of winds and had all day and beat up off the coast of Madagascar to the S and the S W saw some get to the leeward of Orange Bay where we are bound for but no luck.
