saw one sail in the morning
the Island of Juan de Chocoma
at nine o'clock and went ship and lost sight of
it at two P.M. so ended the day

S 18 This day we had a strong breeze all day and
saw nothing so ended the day

M 19 This day we had a strong breeze all day did
not turn the reefs and set the top sails saw
the Canton and had her in sight all day

S 20 This day we had a strong breeze all day with a
heavy sea saw a school of whales at half past
eleven and found four boats and the waist
struck a small ball and we chased the school 15 miles
and gave them up got on board at five P.M.
and cut in the whale and stood quarter watches

M 21 This day we had a strong breeze in the morning but
died away calm at noon cleared away the land in the
morning and started the works at nine o'clock saw
a plenty of porpoises at dinner saw a finback

S 22 This day we had a strong light breeze steady
all day got through trying out at daylight
and had 25 lbs turned up saw nothing

S 23 To day we had strong breeze all day saw but this
in the morning at the lie bow and ran for
them but did not make them out

S 24 To day we had a strong breeze all day saw
nothing broke out the after hull and stowed down
our oil 96 lbs 70 of sperm which makes 1980
all told

S 25 To day we had a good breeze in the morning but died
to a light one at noon saw nothing but fish
saw a whole watch at night

M 26 To day we had a light breeze all day we saw
a plenty of blackfish at sunset and some
porpoises and sheffards wet ball

S 27 To day we had a light breeze in the morning
and a calm at ten o'clock and continued
so the remainder of the day nothing done
but making spanzan saw nothing

Had a strong breeze all day 31
saw a plenty of porpoises and blackfish
and started the top sails fore and aft
at eight P.M. so ended the day

S 29 To day we had a good breeze all day fitted new
fore and aft sails in the forenoon
and made spanzan the remainder of the day
saw a plenty of fish and porpoises

S 30 To day we had a strong breeze all day took in
the main top gallant sail at sunset saw a
finback but nothing more

S 31 To day we still had a strong breeze all day
with a heavy sea with nothing in sight
broke out water in the forenoon and wet
hold after dinner took in sail at night
and stood quarter watches

S 1st Sept. 1850 To day we had a moderate breeze with
squalls and heavy sea and some rain saw some
fish but nothing more saw five water
spouts

M 2 To day we had a light breeze and calm with
some squalls saw some rain saw some
fish but nothing more saw five water
spouts

S 3 To day we had a light breeze and calm
with some rain squalls and water spouts
in sight saw some porpoises and fish
in day number

M 4 To day we had a steady breeze all day saw a
plenty of porpoises and fish and
caught a large porpoise at four P.M. the
mate has been sick for a week with the fever
and got about again today

S 5 To day we had a steady breeze all day
doyle reefed the fore and main top sails
in the fore noon and saw a large wreck
and ran for it but saw nothing more of it
saw a large sunfish after dinner

S 6 To day we had a light breeze all day and
saw nothing to speak of caught a large
sheep after dinner that had seven rows of
teeth and so ended the day
