

- S 7 To day we had a moderate gale. The el until one P.M. forecasted on the board track saw nothing. Through the fog we saw some speckled gulls.
- S 8 To day we had a moderate gale in the morning but it was gradually and set the sea and mistier. At half past ten P.M. saw one pilot whale and some birds.
- W 9 To day we had a strong breeze in the morning and set the vessel for miles in the morning but then in at ten P.M. for the wind went to a moderate gale with heavy squalls. At one dolphin and all hands engaged in cleaning the muckets for sale in Augustine Bay where we are bound to recruit ship, and soon at the moon full for we are cruising off Cape Orientus now.
- T 10 To day we had a moderate gale with a heavy sea running. All day we saw nothing but birds. All hands were cleaning muckets so before we end the day at will and many more.
- W 11 To day we had a moderate breeze with nothing in sight but we got through cleaning the muckets and laid out water.
- T 12 To day we had a good breeze with nothing in sight. Cleaned a mucket and put some rats on the main rigging and set some of the rigging.
- T 13 To day we had a strong breeze all day with nothing in sight. All hands engaged in making rings and knives and setting hold.
- S 14 To day we had a strong breeze with nothing in sight nor like to be. All hands engaged in making rings and knives and setting hold.
- S 15 To day we had a light breeze with nothing in sight. At two o'clock P.M. and took whale watches at night.
- W 16 To day we had a light breeze all day with nothing in sight. All hands busy making carrying and setting up rigging (sails) the day.

- T 17 To day we had a light breeze. Set up some of the stage and caught a porpoise and saw sharks at sunset four miles off.
- W 18 To day we had a light breeze in the morning but increased to a gale by night. Took in cable and have too at four P.M. saw a sail in the morning and a sunfish (so ends the day).
- T 19 To day we had a heavy gale all day. Wave ship. The times and reefs the fore sail saw nothing.
- S 20 To day we had a light breeze all day. Saw nothing but grasshoppers. All hands engaged in setting up rigging. We are bound in.
- S 21 To day we had a light breeze. Saw the land in the morning and got to anchor at four P.M. in Augustine Bay found the Florida at anchor here recruiting.
- From the 21st to the 23rd laid in Port getting work done.
- S 22 got under way at 10 light. This morning in company with the Florida and stood to sea. Spoke one another after dinner and gave in till dark coming free to the H. crew. nothing.
- W 23 This morning we had a strong breeze with a heavy sea. Saw several whales at daylight and called all hands and lowered their boats and got most on and found them to be sunfishes. The Florida still in company.
- T October 1st 1850 To day we had a steady breeze all day with nothing in sight but the Florida. Stearing to the S.W. bound to Tristan.
- W 2 To day we had a light breeze all day with nothing in sight but porpoises and I caught one. Saw four gull and sails and topmast staysails and under some running rigging new and overhauled the main top gallant backstay.
- T 9 To day we had a light breeze. All saw a plenty of finbacks but nothing more.
