S 27 To day we had a light breeze in the morning but increased
in the afternoon to a double reefed top sail breeze at night
of the Sch. Esmer at one P.M. bound to the E. Long
9.50 Lat 34.40 saw two Right Whales at five P.M. but
did not lower for them raised by Leander Smith
saw finbacks a plenty and some whales that we
did not make out before dark so end the day

S 28 To day we had a strong breeze in the morning with fog
and increased to a moderate gale at night in the afternoon
breakfast and lower clear off at ten P.M. and did
not make out before dark so end the day

S 29 To day we had a strong breeze in the morning and increased
to a gale before night saw one whale bound to
the Eastward but nothing more so end the day

S 30 To day we had a heavy gale in the morning with rain squalls
and continued so until after dinner and did away
gradually set double reefed top sails at four P.M. saw nothing
so end the day as usual and many more between the islands

S 31 To day we had a moderate gale in the morning with nothing
in sight but killed down so that we set double reefed sails
at six P.M. so end the day

S 32 To day we had a strong breeze in the morning in the
morning and continued so through the day saw a
sail to windward at five P.M. so end the day

S 33 To day we had a strong breeze in the morning from
the S.W. with some fog but cleared the S.E. at
eight P.M. steered at night till twelve then the
breeze to the Eastward and we steered W. saw nothing

S 34 To day we had the wind from the E. a good breeze
all day steering to the W. saw nothing but some
porpoises struck in and lost them so end the day

S 35 To day we had a light air from the E. all day with
nothing in sight steering to the W. at night down the
fore top sails and mended it and bent it across the
main top sail the same so end the day

S 36 To day we had light wind and calm went down for the main
top sail and fore sail and mended them and bent them
again saw nothing

37 To day we had a light breeze and calm all day
with nothing in sight went up the main sail
and jib and mended them and bent them again
bent out for water so end the day

S 37 To day we had a light breeze all day with nothing
in sight went down the main top sail and mended it
and bent it again so end the day

S 38 To day we had a strong breeze from the north west
steering to the S.W. all day until six P.M. and kept off
W. with the wind freshening saw nothing

S 39 To day we had a strong breeze with rain in the
morning wind from the E. but hauled to the W. at eight
at 10 and cleared off wet hold and saw nothing

S 40 To day we had a calm in the morning with light
showers of rain but increased to a strong breeze at night
saw a sail bound to the S. at six P.M. and end the day

S 41 To day we had a strong breeze with heavy
rain squalls but cleared away at towards night saw
nothing so end the day

S 42 To day we had a good breeze from the E. and
increased to a strong breeze at night steering
S. saw nothing so end the day

S 43 To day we had a good breeze from the E. all
day but saw nothing so end the day took in sail
at night and stood quarter watch

S 44 To day we had a strong breeze from the E. all day
steering S.E. saw plenty of finbacks just before
night took in sail and lower so end the day

S 45 To day we had a moderate gale and thick raised a
Whale at half past nine at 10 and lower with no
success raised by S. Johnson the wind from the E. steered
S.E. until we raised the whale and then ran S.W. until
one P.M. and then wore ship and steered by the wind
until half past four the it began to rain clear off the
fore and main top sails and fore sails and a large whale
came up under the bows while we were furling sails
but it was too rough to lower finbacks in any quantity

S 46 To day we had a strong breeze all day from the S.W.
of the Emma C. Gene. off at 8 P.M. Little Pine
out 1000 lbs 500 lbs 500 lbs got some letters from
her but none for me so end the day

S 47 To day we had a light breeze and calm with the Emma
and a fog in sight the Emma raised a whale at
five at 10 and lower with no success and the Emma
raised two more at eight at 10 and the Emma
one and barboard boat killed him and he and
top one and the fourth mate raised another
at six P.M. and lower with no success so end the day
