

J 24 To day we had a good breeze all day from the S.E. steering N.E. saw a sail at daylight did some work in the rigging Lat 27.00 Long 31.50

J 25 To day we had a good breeze all day from the S.E. ran a sail to windward steering by the wind with us heading N.W. until noon and tacked and headed E.N.E. the remainder of the day Lat 26.18 Long 30.10

S 26 To day we had a good breeze from the S.W. in the morning but kept hauling to the West and dead away nearly calm at night saw a sail on our lee all day west of the fore and aft in the forenoon saw nothing

S 27 To day we had a good breeze all day from the S.E. stood on the starboard tack saw nothing so ends the day Lat 25.06 Long 35.41

N 28 To day we had the wind from the S and S.W. all day stood on the larboard tack raised the fore and main masts did some work in the rigging Lat 24.19 Long 35.59

J 29 To day we had a strong breeze all day with some rain squalls from the S.W. stood on the larboard tack all day and tacked at sunset started a pipe of water and did some rigging work saw nothing Lat 24.00 Long 34.00

N 30 To day we had a good breeze all day from the S.E. stood on the starboard tack all day and tacked at sunset saw some breeches on our lee and raised a sail on the lee bow at three P.M. on the larboard tack still engaged in rigging work Lat 23.14 Long 35.00

S May 1 1818 To day we had a strong breeze all day with squalls from the S.W. the S.W. stood on the starboard tack all day saw a sail on the lee at daylight standing with us and raised another on the lee standing to the S. rattled down the larboard rigging Lat 22.46 Long 33.48

N 2 To day we had a light breeze and rain in the forepart later part heavy squalls of wind and rain from the S.W. saw nothing got some oil and lead Lat 21.00 Long 33.15

S 3 To day we had a good breeze all day from the S.E. steering N.E. saw a sail at daylight in our wake west of the forenoon and set the foremast standing sail and sent up the fore and main royal masts and set the main top gall standing sail after dinner Lat 19.34 Long 32.18

S 4 To day we had a good breeze from the S.W. with rain squalls all day carrying all sail steering N.W. with nothing in sight and nothing doing Lat 16.13 Long 32.23 at three P.M. by Clock

N 5 To day we had a steady breeze all day saw a sail on the lee beam rattled down the fore top mast rigging and gave some running rigging saw some breeches Lat 19.37 Long 32.19 at two P.M.

S 6 To day we had a light breeze all day from the S.W. saw nothing rattled down the fore rigging and masts and commenced the main and main top mast Lat 11.21 Long 32.13 at two P.M. by Clock

N 7 To day we had a light breeze and calm all day saw a barque steering the S. but nothing more did some work in the rigging Lat 09.16 by dead Reck Long 32.59 W by Clock

S 8 To day we had a light breeze S.W. & S. standing on the starboard tack saw a sail steering to the S. and some work in the rigging Lat 7.22 Long 32.07 at noon by Clock

S 9 To day we had a light breeze all day from the S.E. steering N.W. with nothing in sight except the yards but tops for painting got a luncheon at three P.M. Lat 05.12 S Long 31.53

N 10 To day we had a light steady breeze all day hauled aback at 10.00 in the morning and lay until daylight and saw the Island of St. Jean de Leon at daylight with three sails in sight one steering S. two steering N.W. held in the forenoon Lat 03.10 S Long 32.29 at three P.M.

S 11 To day we had a steady breeze all day steering N.W. wind S.E. with nothing in sight Lat 01.00 S Long 33.42 at two P.M. by Clock

N 12 To day we had a light wind from the S.W. to S.E. compassed to wash ship had a plenty of rain Lat 01.16 Long 34.29 at two P.M.
