Fore part strong breeze at 6 P.M. the wind hauled to westward steering S.W. with all sail set latter part light breeze from S.W. steering by the wind to S.

Fore part light air from S.W. steering by the wind to S at 6 P.M. saw sail to the westward Middle part calm latter part S breeze from South steering by the wind to E.S.E.

Fore part light breeze from S steering by the wind to E.S.E. at 6 P.M. took to S.W. one sail in sight Middle and latter part calm

Saturday June the 15th 1839

Fore part of this day strong breeze from the N.E. steering S.W. by compass with all sail set Middle part strong breeze from N.E. latter part more moderate

at 6 A.M. the wind hauled to E by S steering by the wind to E.S.E. Lat 23.32 Long 25.42

Sunday June the 16th 1839

Fore part of this day fine breeze from N.E. by N steering S.W. by compass at 2 P.M. took a lunar observation by measuring the distance of the moon from the sun Long 26.22 W. Middle and latter part breeze and cloudy Lat 21.06 Long 25.33 W.

Monday June the 17th 1839

Fore part of this day light breeze Middle and latter part fine breeze steering S.W. by compass all sail set Lat 18.50 Long 25.30 W.

Tuesday June the 18th 1839

Fore part this day a fine breeze from N.E. steering S.W. by compass at 2 P.M. got a lunar observation by measuring the distance of the moon from the sun and found the Long to be 26.04 Long by Chron 25.30 Middle part fine breeze at 5 A.M. saw the island of St. Anthony bearing S.E. Distance 5 leagues saw a bridge steering to the south latter part fine breeze Lat 16.40 N Long by Chron 25.00 W.

Wednesday June the 19th 1839

Fore part of this day fine breeze at 5 A.M. saw island of St. Anthony bearing S.E. Distance 12 miles at 9 A.M. the island bore W Distance 14 miles the Capt. went on shore and got some dogs a fine breeze from N.E. bore the barque the hallstone of Salem 3 1/2 days out Lat 14.50 Long 24.15 W.

Thursday June the 20th 1839

Fore part strong breeze from N.E. at 5 P.M. the Capt. came on board kept of S.W. Middle part calm latter part a fine breeze from N.E. steering S.W. by compass Lat 13.53 Long 24.38 W.
