Brig bound to Liverpool at 5 P.M. spoke
the Atlantic of Nantucket 37 Days out bound to
New England Lat 12.30 Long 24.30 West

Saturday June the 22nd 1839
All this day light airs from N.E. Steaming S by W
by Compass at 7 A.M. saw a Shoal of Black
Fish Lat 10.37 Long 24.36.30 W

Sunday June the 23rd 1839
Fore part light airs from N.E. Steaming
S by W by Compass at 4 P.M. spoke the
Atlantic of Nantucket at 2 P.M. the wind
hauled to North latter part fine breeze from N
Steaming S by Compass Lat 9.00 Long 24.25 W

Monday June the 24th 1839
Fore part of this day fine breeze and cloudy with
rain wind from North Steaming South by Compass
Middle and latter part light breezes and calm with rain
Lat 8.06 Long 24.20 W

Tuesday June the 25th 1839
Fore part light breezes and calm cloud with rain 2 ships
in sight at 9 P.M. took in the studding sails at
9 P.M. the wind hauled to the Westward and strong
breeze at 3 A.M. took in F. Gib and Fore top galeant
sail at 4 A.M. took in M top galeant sail
latter part rain Lat 6.45 Long 23.49 W

Wednesday June 26th 1839
Fore part of this day fine breeze and rain wind from S.E. W
steaming by the wind to S.E. Middle part a fine
breeze and pleasant weather at 5 A.M. tacked to the
S.W. at 7 A.M. the wind hauled to the S.E. W again
were ship heading to S.E. one ship in sight
Lat 6.29 Long 22.23 W

Thursday June the 27th 1839

Fore part a fine breeze from S.E. Steaming by the wind
to S.W. Middle and latter part the same
Lat 5.43 Long 23.39 W

Friday June the 28th 1839
Fore part of this day light breeze from S.E. Steaming by the
wind to the S.W. at 1 P.M. spoke the Atlantic of Nantucket
Middle and latter part light breeze heading to the
Eastward Lat 6.19 Long 21.33 W

Saturday June the 29th 1839
Fore part light breezes from S.E. to E Steaming by the wind
to Eastward at 4 P.M. tacked to the Westward from 4 to 6 P.M.
rain middle part light breezes and calm at 6 A.M.
tacked to the Eastward wind from South so much
Lat 6.11 Long 21.20 W

Sunday June the 30th 1839
Commenced with a breeze from S Steaming by the wind
to the S.E. at 4 P.M. calm at 5 P.M. a breeze from S.W. on
heading S.E. the rest of this day with a fine breeze one
sail in sight Lat 5.47 Long 19.10 W

Monday July the first 1839
Fore part fine breeze from South Steaming by the wind to
S.E. Middle part the same at 7 A.M. tacked to S.W.
at 4 P.M. the wind hauled to the South again
and tacked to the S.E. with a fine breeze from S by W
Lat 5.36 Long 17.20 W

Tuesday July the 2nd 1839
Fore part fine breeze from S Steaming by the wind to
S.E. Middle and latter part the same at 8 A.M.
tacked to the S.W. saw one sail Steaming by the
wind to the S.W. Lat 5.19 Long 16.20 W
