

Remarks on Board *Nargue* Core on a Whaling Voyage

Wednesday July the 3rd 1839

Fore part of this day a fine breeze from S by E steering by the wind to S and W at 7 P.M. sun southerly took in the 4th Gib at 11 P.M. took in fore top gallant sail at 6 A.M. set the top gallant sail and 4th Gib latter part fine breeze from S by E Lat 4.11 N Long 17.24 W

Thursday July 4th 1839

Fore part this day brisk breeze from S by E steering by the wind to S by W by W Middle part strong breeze took in 4th Gib and 5th top gallant sail latter part more moderate set them again Lat 2.29 S Long 18.55 W

Friday July the 5th 1839

at 10 A.M. Fore part a fine breeze from S by E steering by the wind to S by W Middle and latter part a fine breeze from S by E at 6 P.M. steering by the wind to S by W saw 2 sails steering by the wind to S by W Lat 1.01 S Long 20.30 W

Saturday July the 6th 1839

Fore part of this day a fine breeze from S by E steering by the wind to S by W Middle part fine breeze from S by E at 10 A.M. got a lunar observation by measuring the distance of the sun from the moon and found the long to be 21.13.30 Lat 00.18 South

Sunday July the 7th 1839

Fore part fine breeze from S by E steering by the wind to S by W Middle part fine breeze at 10 A.M. got a lunar observation by measuring the distance of the sun from the moon Long 22.08 W Lat 2.00 S

Monday July 8th 1839

Fore part fine breeze from S by E steering by the wind to S by W middle part brisk breeze at 8 A.M. a squall of rain took in 5th top gallant sail at 11 M set it again Lat 4.06 S Long 23.37 W

the North Atlantic Ocean bound to Newland H. Wharves South Atlantic Ocean.

Tuesday July 9th 1839

Fore part a fine breeze from S by E steering by the wind to S by W middle part the same rather strong breeze and squally at 11 A.M. took in fore top gallant sail and 4th Gib Lat 6.19 S Long 24.45 W

Wednesday July 10th 1839

Fore part strong breeze and squally Middle and latter part brisk breeze from S by E steering by the wind to S by W Lat 8.09 S Long 25.21 W

Thursday July 11th 1839

Fore part of this day brisk breeze from S by E steering by the wind to S by W Middle and latter part fine breeze saw a bark ship steering to the S W Lat 10.13 S Long 26.37

Friday July 12th 1839

All this 24 hours fine breeze from S by E steering by the wind to the S by W Lat 12.03 S Long 27.28 W

Saturday July 13th 1839

Fore part a fine breeze from S by E steering by the wind to S by W Middle part the same latter part moderate breeze from S by E Lat 13.47 S Long 28.14 W

Sunday July 14th 1839

Fore part light breeze from S by E steering by the wind to S by W Middle and latter part fine breeze at 8 A.M. saw a shoal of black fish board 2 boats and chased 3 miles to the and give them up and come on board at 10 M A.M. got a lunar observation by measuring the distance of the sun and moon and found the long to be 28.54 W Lat 14.52 S
