

Remarks on board Bark Cora South Atlantic Ocean

Friday August 9<sup>th</sup> 1839  
Fore part strong breeze from N.E. steering  
by the wind to S.E. by E. by S. compass latter part  
wind from N.E. steering E.S.E. by S. compass  
Lat 38.24 & Long 00 35.45 East

Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part strong breeze from N.E. steering  
E.S.E. by S. compass latter part strong breeze from  
S.E. by S. steering E.S.E. by S. compass Lat 38.53 Long 3.23

Sunday August 11<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part brisk breeze from N.E. steering  
E.S.E. by S. compass latter part strong breeze  
and variable weather steering E.S.E. by S. compass  
Lat 39.06 & Long 07.12 East

Monday August 12<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part strong breeze from N.E. steering  
E.S.E. by S. compass at 3 P.M. double reef the  
to sail and took in the gill at 5 P.M. took  
in the main sail at 2 A.M. the wind hauled  
to the N.W. at 6 A.M. the wind set the main  
sail latter part strong breeze and fine weather  
steering E.S.E. by S. compass Lat 39.03 Long 11.12

Tuesday August 13<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part strong breeze from N.W. steering  
E.S.E. by S. compass at 4 P.M. had a heavy squall from N.W.  
double reef the top stibs latter part more  
moderate made sail steering E.S. East by S.  
compass Lat 39.04 & Long 14.00 East

bound to Newland on a Whaling Voyage Starman Mast

Wednesday August 14<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part brisk breeze from S.W. steering E.S. East  
by S. compass at 8 P.M. the breeze increasing at 10 P.M.  
double reef the top sails at 4 A.M. took in the  
fore top sail latter part brisk Gale from N steering  
E.S.E. by S. compass Lat 39.05 Long 16.25 E

Thursday August 15<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part brisk Gale from N steering S.E. by E. by S.  
compass at 2 P.M. set the fore top sail latter part  
brisk gale and variable weather from 9 A.M. to  
noon the wind moderated Lat 39.25 Long 20.11 E

Friday August 16<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part commences with a fine breeze from N  
at 1/2 past 1 P.M. a brisk Gale from N steering E.S.E.  
by S. compass pleasant weather at 7 P.M. the  
wind hauled sudden to the N.W. and moderated  
from 11 P.M. to 7 A.M. calm latter part a fine breeze  
from S.W. steering E.S.E. by S. compass Lat 39.53 & Long 24.03 E

Saturday August 17<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part light breeze from S.W. and pleasant  
weather steering E.S.E. by S. compass latter part  
light breeze from South and pleasant weather one  
Ship in sight Lat 38.24 Long 27.12

Sunday August 18<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore light breeze from South and pleasant weather  
at 2 P.M. saw 2 Right Whales board 2 boats and  
shoot them 3 miles to the windward then give  
up the chase and come on board middle part calm  
at 3 A.M. a breeze from E by N steering to S.E. by  
S. compass Lat 38.46 & Long 29.23 E

Monday August 19<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part a fine breeze from N.E. by E steering by the  
wind to the S.E. by S. compass at 2 P.M. got a Lunar  
Observation at 2 A.M. the wind moderated  
and hauled to the East steering by the wind  
to S.E. by S. compass Lat 29.06 Long 30.22 E
