Tuesday August 20th 1839
Fore part light breeze from East steering by the
wind to the S. E. By compass one ship in sight
steering to the south at 3 A.M. the wind hauled
to the East by steering by the wind to S. E.
fine pleasant weather Lat 40.06 Long 31.15 E

Wednesday August 21st 1839
Fore part fine light breeze from E by steering by
By compass at 4 P.M. the wind hauled to N. E.
steering S. E. latter part light breeze and rainy
saw one ship steering S. E. Lat 40.15 Long 33.00 E

Thursday August 22nd 1839
Fore part light breezes with rain steering S. E. By
compass at 4 P.M. the wind hauled to N. E. W.
at 7 P.M. the wind hauled to N. E. steering
S. E. By compass at 5 A.M. the wind hauled to N. E.
at 10 A.M. the wind to S. W. with a fresh breeze doubt-
less the topsails steering S. E. By compass
Lat 40.05 Long 35.00 E

Friday August 23rd 1839
Fore part strong breeze from S. W. steering S. E. By
compass at 5 P.M. saw Brig steering S. E. By compass
latter part strong breezes and fine weather at 11 A.M.
A.M. saw a Rite Whale Lat 39.42 Long 38.00 E

Saturday August 24th 1839
Fore part strong breeze from N. E. W. saw several
Rite Whales but to regret to hear the boats at
3 P.M. the wind moderated at 3 1/2 hours 2 boats
did not strike at 4 1/2 hours on board at 5 P.M.
hove ship to at 9 P.M. the wind hauled to N.
at 12 o'clock wore ship heading to N. E. with a
strong breeze at 5 A.M. the wind hauled to N. E.
in heavy squalls steering S. E. By compass at
7 A.M. strong gale took in the main topsail
and hove ship to latter part strong gale and
clear weather Lat 39.40 Long 40.00 E

Remarks on a Whaling Voyage Humphrey Charman

Sunday August 25th 1839
Fore part strong gale from N. W. and clear
weather heading to N. E. By compass at 7 P.M. set the N.
top sail steering S. E. By compass at 3 A.M. steering
S. E. By compass latter fine breeze and pleasant weather
Lat 39.34 Long 41.56

Monday August 26th 1839
Fore part fine breeze and pleasant weather steering S. E.
By compass this afternoon saw 3 Rite Whales board our
boats but could not strike latter part brisk breeze
and pleasant weather Lat 39.46 Long 45.23 East

Tuesday August 27th 1839
Fore part strong breeze from N. E. steering S. E. By
compass at 5 P.M. took in S. top sail main sent and
took in fore sail and hove to heading S. E. By
compass latter part brisk gale at 7 A.M. the
wind hauled to N. at 9 A.M. hauled to S. W. strong
gale and rain Lat 39.48 Long 47.00 East

Wednesday August 28th 1839
Fore part brisk gale from S. W. steering S. E. By compass
at 5 P.M. steering S. E. By compass latter part a fine
breeze and pleasant weather saw a brig steering S. E.
Lat 38.56 Long 51.04

Thursday August 29th 1839
Fore part light breezes and pleasant weather steering
S. E. By compass at 8 P.M. the wind hauled to
S. E. steering by the wind to Eastward at 3 A.M.
the wind hauled to N. E. W. steering S. E. By compass
with a brisk breeze Lat 38.42 Long 53.51 East

Friday August 30th 1839
Fore part strong breeze from N. E. steering S. E. By
compass at 5 P.M. a brisk gale doubtless the top
sails latter part brisk gale at 7 A.M. the wind
hauled to the South steering by the wind to S. E.
By compass
Lat 38.32 Long 57.06
