

# Remarks on board the Harb. Coe on a Whaling Voyage Humbury Tharmon Master

Saturday Sept 21<sup>st</sup> 1839

Fore part strong gale at 1 P.M. took in the fore top sail and hift to head up N.W. by E. drift 2 miles per hour E by N per compass at 5 P.M. moderated set the Main top sail and kept of E by E per compass at 6 P.M. set the fore sail at 7 P.M. set fore top sail fine pleasant weather Middle part a fine breeze latter part calm and rainy weather Lat 44.53 Long 122.57 East

Sunday Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> 1839

Fore part a light breeze from the N steering E by E per compass at 5 P.M. the wind hauled to the N.W. at 4 A.M. to 3 A.M. calm latter part a brisk breeze from the E by E and rainy steering by the wind to the S by W per compass at 11 A.M. double reefed the top sail Lat 45.20 Long 124.

Monday Sept 23<sup>rd</sup> 1839

Fore part A brisk Gale from the E by E steering by the wind to the S by W at 3 P.M. the wind hauled to S by S steering by the wind to S.W. at 4 P.M. took in the E by E at 7 P.M. took in the fore top sail at 8 P.M. wore ship and took in the fore sail head up E by E of N.E. drift 2 miles per hour at 10 P.M. wind hauled to the S by W head up E by E drift N.E. 2 miles per hour at 1 A.M. the wind hauled to S.W. 2 miles per hour N.E. at 4 A.M. a strong gale took in the main top sail at 6 A.M. picked in to a sea and took the end off Lib Bophr latter strong gale from S.W. Lat 45.55 Long 124.10 East

Tuesday Sept 24<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part strong gale from the S.W. drift N.W. by E per compass 2 miles per hour at 6 P.M. the wind hauled to W by W steering E per compass set the Main top sail at 12 o'clock the wind hauled to W at 3 A.M. steering E by E per compass at 7 A.M. un bent the N top sail latter part brisk Gale Lat 45.46 Long 125.

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Wednesday Sept 25<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part a brisk gale from West steering E by E per compass at 5 P.M. bent the Main top sail at 9 P.M. the wind hauled to N.W. a brisk gale and heavy squalls and rain at 1 A.M. took in the fore top sail at 2 A.M. took in the fore sail at 2 1/2 A.M. the wind the wind veered to the N by E a heavy gale at 4 A.M. took in the Main top sail at 8 A.M. the wind veered to S.W. by W latter part a heavy gale Lat 46.00 Long 130.46 East

Thursday Sept 26<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part a strong gale from S.W. by W at 3 P.M. moderated set the Main top sail and fore sail kept of E by E per compass a heavy sea a running latter part a fine breeze from the N.W. at 5 A.M. set the fore top sail and N top gallant sail and turned the reefs out of the main top sail Lat 46.09 Long 133.45 East

Friday Sept 27<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part a fine pleasant breeze from the W steering E by E per compass at 8 P.M. the wind veered to the N.W. by W latter part a fine brisk breeze Lat 46.28 Long 138.00 East

Saturday Sept 28<sup>th</sup> 1839

Fore part a brisk breeze from N.W. by W steering E by E at 3 P.M. steering East per compass at 11 P.M. took in the top gallant sail a strong breeze from the N.W. by W at 11 A.M. double reefed the top sail at 1 A.M. took in the fore top sail at brisk gale at 11 A.M. the wind moderated steering E by N per compass at 11 A.M. set the fore top sail at 12 noon made all sail a fine breeze from the N.W. by W Lat 46.35 Long 142.15 East
