

Remarks on board the Bark Cora on a

Thursday Jan 16th 1840

Fore part of this Day light breeze from the N and pleasant weather steering W S W saw 3 ships one a Boiling Middle and latter part wind from the N E and rainy steering by the wind to the Westward Lat 45.15 Long 177.15

Friday Jan 17th 1840

Fore part a breeze from the N and foggy steering by the wind to S W Middle and latter part a strong breeze from the South at 12 noon ship headed to the Westward saw two ships latter part clear Lat 45.12 Long 179.28 East

Saturday Jan 18th 1840

Fore part of this Day light breeze from the S W and fine pleasant weather steering by the wind to W N W two ships in sight at 6 P.M. spoke the Gloucester 1000 1840 Middle part a strong breeze from the N N W heading to the westward at 9 A.M. the wind shifted sudden to the South latter part a brisk gale Lat 45.10 Long 178.49 E

Sunday Jan 19th 1840

All this Day a brisk gale from the S heading to the W under close reef N topsail Lat 44.31 Long 178.31

Monday Jan 20th 1840

Fore part of this Day a strong breeze from the S at 1 P.M. set the fore sail and fore topsail saw 2 ships heading to the S E Middle part calm latter part a fine breeze from the N steering S W Per compass Lat 44.18 Long 178.29 East

Tuesday Jan 21st 1840

Fore part of this Day a fine breeze from the N and pleasant weather steering S W 3 ships in sight Middle and latter part the same latter part steering South Lat 45.00 Long 177.35 E

Wednesday Jan 22nd 1840

Fore part of this Day a fine breeze from the N W steering by the wind to W S W fine pleasant weather saw number of Fin Backs Middle part a strong breeze from the S W steering by the wind to the S E at 3 P.M. the wind hauled sudden to the South latter a light breeze saw 3 ships Lat 44.57 Long 178.07 East

Thursday Jan 23rd 1840

Fore part of this Day a fine breeze from the W and pleasant weather steering East Middle part light breeze at 3 P.M. the wind hauled to the N E steering S E latter part a strong breeze saw one ship Lat 45.32 Long 179.03 E

Friday Jan 24th 1840

Fore part of this Day a brisk breeze from the N E steering S W fine pleasant weather Middle part foggy at 8 A.M. the wind from S W steering by the wind to W fine weather Lat 45.42 Long 178.31

Saturday Jan 25th 1840

Fore part a strong breeze from S W steering by the wind to W under double reef top sails Middle and latter part a light breeze and fine pleasant weather saw one ship and number of Fin Backs Lat 45.22 Long 177.17 East
