

Remarks on board Bark Cora on a Whaling voyage
Humphrey Therman Master

Wednesday Dec 23rd 1840
Fore part brisk gale from S by W heading to
S by E under topmast main top sail and
fore sail employed in stowing down
oil at 7 P.M. the wind hauled to W
Middle and latter part strong breeze and
a heavy swell from S latter part muddied
in stowing down oil Lat 42.09 Long 164.22

Thursday Dec 24th 1840
All this day strong breeze from S by W and
loudly steering by the wind to S by W Lat 42.43
Long 164.22

Friday Dec 25th 1840
Fore part strong breeze from S by W steering by
the wind to S by W at 3 P.M. the wind hauled to W
at 6 P.M. wore ship to S by W and punt ship and fore
the main sum under Middle and latter
part strong breeze from W by N Lat 43.17
Long 164.43

Saturday Dec 26th 1840
All this day brisk gale from S and squally
heading to E by E at 5 A.M. took in the fore
sail Lat 43.25 Long 164.13

Sunday Dec 27th 1840
Fore part brisk gale from S and squally
at 6 P.M. wore ship to W by N and punt ship
700 strokes set the fore sail Middle part stowed
breeze at daylight set the fore top sail at 10 A.M.
wore ship and made all sail at 11 A.M. the wind
hauled to W by N employed in scupping down
Lat 42.15 Long 164.17

Monday Dec 28th 1840
Fore part strong breeze from W by N and variable
weather steering by the wind to S at 7 P.M. stowed
S by E stowed half watches at 5 A.M. the wind hauled
S by E took in the main top gallant
sail and double reefed the fore top sail at
7 A.M. steering E by E with a strong breeze from
S by W Lat 43.10 Long 162.39

Tuesday Dec 29th 1840
Fore part strong breeze from S by W steering E by E
pleasant weather Middle and latter part
light breeze all hands employed in bending
new sails Lat 43.35 Long 166.08

Wednesday Dec 30th 1840
Fore part strong breeze from S by W steering
S by E employed in bending sails at 9 P.M.
set the fore top mast studding sail at 9 P.M.
took in the fore top mast studding sail Middle
part variable weather at 5 A.M. the wind hauled
to W by N at 7 set the studding sail latter
part pleasant weather Lat 44.59 Long 163.22

Thursday Dec 31st 1840
Fore part strong breeze from S by W steering
E by S pleasant weather Middle part variable weather
at 1 P.M. took in the fore top mast studding sail
and main top gallant sail at 5 A.M. made
all sail pleasant weather at 9 A.M. sent down
the fore top gallant mast Lat 45.03 Long 155.01

Friday January 1st 1841
Fore part a brisk breeze from S by W and
pleasant weather steering E by S all sail set
Middle and latter part the same at 3 P.M.
steering E by E at 10 A.M. steering E by S Lat 45.22
Long 152.05

Saturday Jan 2nd 1841
Fore part strong breeze from S by W steering E by S
with all sail set variable weather Middle part
foggy latter part steering E by S employed in
washing ship Lat 46.04 Long 149.31

Sunday Jan 3rd 1841
Fore part brisk breeze from S by W steering E by S
at 6 P.M. the wind hauled to S by W steering E
at 7 P.M. saw several right whales took in
the fore top mast studding sail and left to
but to rugged to loose at 3 A.M. steering E
with a strong breeze from S by W Lat 46.00
Long 145.51
